Multi-Phase Career Keeps Jessel Busy

HOLLYWOOD — EXCLUSIVE INTERVIEW: George Jessel is hopping a boat for Paris this month, taking along 31 million dollars. Quite enough for general expenses, you'd say, but this happens to be a gift for Israel, where George will eventually land via Athens.

He's just about the most able money raiser for charitable purposes this country ever saw, and it's seen plenty of George on such missions in the past year. Talking it over with him in Las Vegas recently, he staggered us with some of the facts.

"It took 200 luncheon and dinner speeches to do it," said George with disarming casualness. He's not the kind to brag of his accomplishments. "At one time I was hitting 70 cities in 70 days."

"You don't happen to be twins, do you?" we gasped, "because someone looking a lot like you was also making regular TV appearances, some theatrical rounds, and writing a couple of books. And here you are now, heading the El Rancho's show." From our choice front table the room was packed to capacity.

"It was a pretty fast pace," he admitted, "but incidentally, this is my farewell appearance in night clubs. We crowded him right into that. 'What's coming up?' What's new?"

"Well," he smiled, enjoying our questions, "in the fall I start a new TV show, 'Inside Show Business.' I do a 15 minutes chat, for one thing." That's bound to be good, because as a speaker and story-teller George was dubbed the "U. S. Toastmaster" by the late Franklin D. "There'll also be variety ranging from entertainment to politics." The latter is one of George's pet subjects.

"What's this we hear about a deal with Howard Hughes?" "He owns the script for 'Bachelor Mother,' I'd like to produce the film, if time allows and we can pin Mr. Hughes down. I'll be producing a film series for TV with that fine young Hoosier, Herb Shriner, at the top. And I'm winding up arrangements now for a pretty big 'Evening With Jessel' type of show which we'll stage in the larger theaters across the country."

That's a large bunch of orders for a fellow who never got past the fourth grade. Drop his writing activities on top of the pile and you have the mountain he's accustomed to moving all the time. Through it all Jessel has remained human, an easy touch for charity, giving freely of his precious time when the underdog will benefit. And the years have made him wise. Dedicated to his 13-year-old daughter Jerilyn, his latest book, "This Way Miss," promises to be a valuable guide to her and other growing young ladies. His "So Help Me" hit the best seller lists, so in authoring, as in entertaining, George excels.

We'd been saving the weightiest question. Now we let it drop. "Do you think there's a chance for the TV and movie industries ever to merge?"

That straightened him up. "First," he returned, "you shouldn't consider either one of them an industry. Motion pictures are amusement. TV is just glamorous advertising." And he went on to point out noted TV personalities who'd never make the grade on a basis of acting talent, but who are top-flight salesmen on TV. Fellows like Godfrey and Garroway. He concluded, "And while the future of movies needn't be dark, motion picture studios' outputs are going to drop to a fourth of their past proportions, while telefilms increase."

He should know. He's in the thick of all fields of entertainment. And to extents that would stagger the rocking chair artists who are more or less content to plug along and wait for the rest of the world to go by. By contrast, Jessel has had the rest of the world to catch up to him.

Flood Control On Tualatin Recommended

WASHINGTON — The Board of Engineers for Rivers and Harbors recommended Friday that a controversial flood control proposal for the Tualatin River, Ore., be transmitted to Congress as a "desirable plan."

The project called for: 1. An \$11,125,000 dam and reservoir at the Gaston site in the river. This was regarded by the board as a local, rather than federal responsibility, since it would be chiefly for irrigation and water supply.

2. Channel improvements along the river and in principal tributaries at a cost of \$17,819,000. This part had strong local opposition.

The board's action left it up to any other federal or state agency or private interest to avail itself of the plan if it so desired.

Timberline Lodge Protests Bar Ban

PORTLAND — The Oregon Liquor Control Commission is defendant in a suit filed in circuit court here by Timberline Lodge, Inc.

The lodge is asking the court to set aside an OLCC order suspending its liquor licenses for seven days effective next Monday. It contended that the order, based on a charge that the lodge allowed a minor to drink and loiter on the premises, is unusual, unwarranted and not based on evidence.
