

Check Cars Before Vacations

Vacation time, to more than 80 per cent of American travelers, is motoring time. For a trouble-free motor vacation, experts agree, now is the time for your pre-trip auto checkup.

The early conditioning is more important than ever, according to the American Automobile Association, in view of both the increased age of many cars on the road today and greater mileages they are being subjected to each year in travel.

Unless you are an experienced auto mechanic, the AAA feels, it is best to turn your car's pre-trip overhaul over to a competent service station, obtaining in

advance an estimate of repair needs for a summer of carefree motoring.

"If, by now, your defroster and car heater have not been disconnected after winter use, they should be attended to immediately," the AAA advises. "Have the service man check the wiring of the radio, air conditioner and cigarette lighter so that poor electrical connections may be repaired or removed."

A check of the ignition system should include inspection of the battery's acid level; cleanliness of the wiring, distributor and plug surfaces, and a look at the generator, oil distributor, battery

cables and terminals. The starter motor and generator may need lubrication, and spark plugs may need adjustment, the AAA warns.

A heavier grade of lubricating oil for warmer weather use is called for now, and it is wise to change your motor oil every 750 to 1,000 miles.

The AAA also advises the car owner to have its engine and chassis oiled and greased, and oil in the transmission and differential changed or renewed. All wheel bearings should be checked and lubricated. Clean or change the oil filter, and clean the crankcase and ventilator filter.



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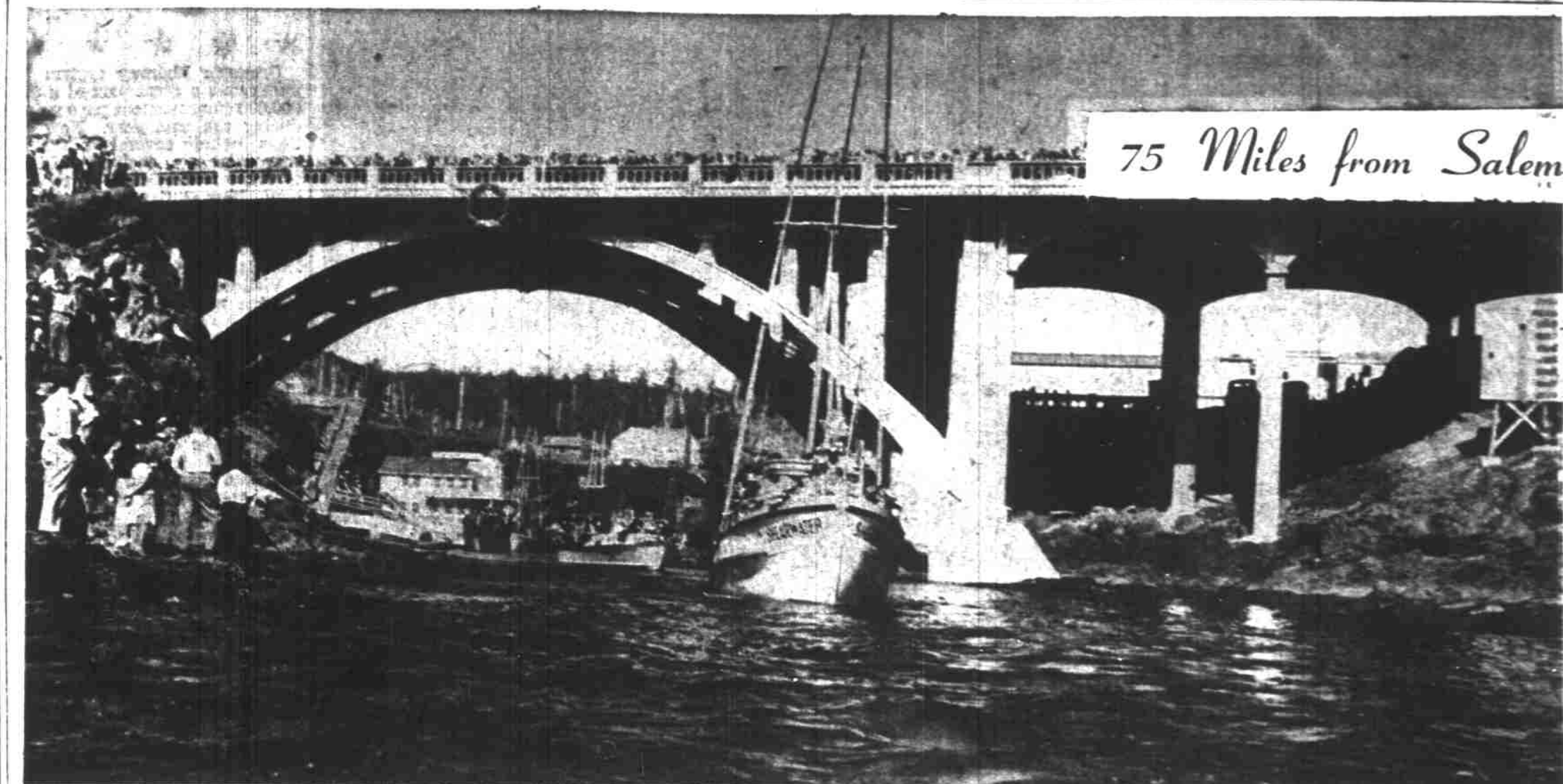
