bank at the time of the bank holiday in 1933. Fearful of shaky bank conditions, he said he withdrew the money and kept it in a tin box for years. He did not bank it again until the late 1940's, he testified.

The government accused him of reporting income for 1946-1950 of \$416,144, when it actually was \$543,296. The government said he paid taxes of \$200,437 when he should have paid \$291,523. Defense attorney Richard

Burke said he has not discussed a possible appeal with Nunan. However, defense motions will be heard by the judge Thursday.
