

Noted Washington Wirepuller Indicted on 10 Perjury Counts

WASHINGTON (AP)—Henry W. (The Dutchman) Grunewald, noted Washington wirepuller, was indicted Thursday on 10 charges of perjury.

Some of the counts involved the same cases. Count No. 1 charged that Grunewald falsely testified to the House subcommittee in April 1953 that he had never discussed tax cases with Daniel A. Bolich, once the nation's No. 2 tax collector. Bolich himself is now under indictment on charges of evading his own income taxes.

FHA Scandal Links Project Near Capital

WASHINGTON (AP)—The Senate Banking Committee's continuing probe of apartment house builders turned suddenly Thursday to a project now rising within sight of the Capitol Building.

Bolich was one of several officials of the Internal Revenue Bureau during the Truman administration with whom Grunewald was on friendly terms.

When first brought before congressional investigators of tax scandals, Grunewald refused to answer any questions and was cited for contempt of Congress. He eventually changed his mind and answered questions, but not to the full satisfaction of his interrogators.

Norman P. Mason, acting commissioner of the Federal Housing Administration, said the Justice Department had been asked to act in the case of the Arlington Towers apartment development, a 22 million dollar structure described as "one of the nation's largest."

Part of the testimony he gave to the grand jury which indicted him Thursday was given while he was serving out his term.

Indochina War Truce Cruel, Says Premier

PARIS (AP)—Premier Pierre Mendes-France reported to the National Assembly Thursday that the Indochina peace he negotiated at Geneva was cruel but that it was the best bargain to be had and it ended a nightmare for France.

He was immediately attacked by Frederick duPont, a member of the government of Joseph Laniel which Mendes-France displaced. DuPont accused the Premier of throwing away advantages in the Geneva negotiations and implied that the Laniel government, if allowed to stay in office, could have had peace and perhaps on better terms.
