shudders. Constantly permeated by a running gag, Hawthorne's weather report has at times been some of the
craziest humor this side of a nut house. Inmates of the
latter are the only ones who could possibly fully understand Hawthorne, but we all appreciate him no end. And
now he's been given a longer, later spot on TV locally
in which to cavort and confuse and ladle up gags which
could only breed beneath his short-cropped thatch.
