

Sewer Rate Raise Stymied By Woodburn Councilman

WOODBURN — New legislation to raise the sewer surcharge against Woodburn water users from 40 to 75 cents a month was stymied at a City Council meeting Tuesday night, but will come up again for a vote Thursday.

Councilmen said the increase was needed to bring in an additional \$400 a month for sewer maintenance work. Three members were prepared to put the bill to final vote but Councilman Jess Fikan vetoed the move, saying the public should be heard before final action.

Jet Fighters Prowl China Seas Skies

HONG KONG (U. S. — U.S. and Red jets Tuesday, prowled the uneasy skies off Hainan, where a British airliner was shot down last week and U.S. fighters bagged two Red planes Sunday.

Commercial planes were flying far south of Hainan Island, the Red air and sea base off the South China coast. Even so, three airliners reported they were buzzed by U.S. or Red jets as far as 120 miles away from Hainan.

In the tense situation, Peiping and Washington exchanged angry protests over the Sunday affair in which U.S. carrier planes shot down two Red propeller planes while guarding a search for survivors from the airliner. Peiping demanded the United States "cease immediately these aggressive acts" or it would be held "entirely responsible."

(An English language version heard in San Francisco said Red China "hereby gives its serious warning to the United States government to stop immediately such acts of aggression or else the U.S. government will have to bear full responsibility for its provocations and suffer the consequences.")

Only 8 of 18 aboard were saved when two Red planes shot down the airliner Friday off Hainan. Peiping apologized to Britain, but London in a note Tuesday accused Red China of violating "international custom and behavior" in hampering rescue operations.

The extent of the U.S. and Communist aerial sweeps in the South China Sea was unfolded by pilots of the three airliners as they landed in Hong Kong from Bangkok.

Capt. Jacques Brugger, pilot of an Air France Constellation, said four planes—"we think they were MIGs (Red jets) but we cannot be sure"—buzzed his plane about 100 miles off Hainan.

He said the four jets followed his plane for four minutes, then barred across the ship's course and vanished.

Capt. Max C. Weber, pilot of a Pan-American plane, said U.S. Navy jets met his plane 120 miles from Hainan and escorted him for several minutes before vanishing.

Capt. Homi B. Misty, pilot of an Air India International plane, said two U.S. jets buzzed him about 80 miles from Hainan and he saw two more about six miles off.

West Lives Up to Name, Rounds Up Wandering Pony

State police officer Floyd West, who's proved expert in the past at rounding up straying horses, had another crack at a wrangler's role Tuesday night.

A call from a motorist came into Salem headquarters, reporting that a shetland pony was obstructing traffic on the highway near Cottage Farm, east of Salem. Bailey Writ Dismissed At Roseburg

ROSEBURG (U. S. — A writ demanding that Donald "Punchy" Bailey—once known as the "boss convict" of the state penitentiary—be produced in circuit court here was dismissed Tuesday.

Judge John L. Foote of St. Helens, who presided at the hearing, said there was no basis now for the writ as the prisoner was no longer in custody here.

Bailey was returned to the state penitentiary July 23 shortly after his attorney, Charles O. Porter, Eugene, filed the writ of habeas corpus, contending Bailey was being held illegally.

Bailey was held as a secret prisoner here from Nov. 13, 1953, to July 23. Warden Clarence T. Gladden, who accused Bailey of being the "boss convict" and a ringleader of the destructive prison riot in July, 1953, had Bailey sent here as a security precaution.

Judge Foote, in announcing his decision, said he was not ruling on the legality of Bailey's being held here instead of at the penitentiary. He limited the ruling, he said, to the "accomplished fact" that Bailey was no longer in custody here and that law enforcement officials therefore were unable to produce him in court.

Porter declined to say what, if any, additional legal steps he planned. However, contempt affidavits against Sheriff Calvin Baird and Gladden still are on file. Judge Foote did not set a date for a hearing on these actions, however, as his court term here is ending soon.

Sen. Ellender Nominated In Louisiana

Sen. Allen J. Ellender won re-nomination in Louisiana's Democratic primary Tuesday while Sen. John L. McClellan, seeking re-nomination in Arkansas, clung stubbornly to an approximate 5,000 majority over three opponents.

In Oklahoma, State Sen. Raymond Cary was the winner on nearly complete unofficial returns in a runoff election for the Democratic gubernatorial nomination.

McClellan, who gained television fame through his participation in the McCarthy-Army hearings, had 142,401 votes to the combined totals of 137,490 for his three opponents. He must face a runoff unless he gains a majority of all the votes.

With 2,056 of Arkansas' 2,322 precincts counted, McClellan's nearest opponent, former Gov. Sid McMath had 109,200 votes. Democratic National Committeeman Paul Chambers had 25,772 and Leonard Ellis of Little Rock, who did not campaign, 2,460.

Several hours earlier McClellan had predicted—and McMath had denied—that the senator would be renominated without the necessity of a runoff.

The 63-year-old Ellender, seeking his fourth term, had a 95,059-vote margin with only 192 of Louisiana's 2,036 precincts missing. He had 247,169 votes to 153,110 for his nearest opponent, Democratic National Committeeman Frank B. Ellis of New Orleans who captured a 4,000-vote edge in his hometown parish. State Rep. Gilbert Faulk of Monroe trailed with 19,106.
