Comedian Finds TV Hard Work But Fun

HOLLYWOOD. — When I finished four years of "live" television, I was almost "dead." It's that much of a strain! When you're making a film, and you think a scene could be improved, you do it over — and over — and, if necessary, over again. Live TV gives you only one chance to get up to bat. It's tough!

But I've had my fun, too. Like the night Ida made her debut. I gave her the cue, and she went blank. I repeated it. All she did was stammer something unintelligible. In desperation, I ad-libbed, "This is what I get for trying to save 65 bucks!" (minimum rate for trained actors).

When Ida finally did speak, y'know what happened? Uh-huh! She said the wrong line. The audience laughed and I cracked: "Oh, you can't divorce a woman just for that!" That line got a bigger hand than anything we expected in the script. After living with me for over 37 years, Ida knows how much applause means to me! Could it be — ? Was this just another example of her throwing me the spotlight — ? When I ask her about it, Ida only laughs — which is the nicest answer a wife can give a comedian!

On one of my shows, guest-star Bob Hope came on a scene about three minutes too early. He wasn't the least bit embarrassed — merely said: "There wasn't much happening — I thought I'd liven things up!"

Television is funny. You never know how the public will react. On one "Comedy Hour," we had three big guest stars for whom we paid thousands of dollars. Our rating — according to Nielsen — was lower than the show where I used a monkey who got paid off in bananas! What was that about the Darwin theory?

Since it was announced that I signed with the Ziv Company to put all my TV shows on film, many in show business have been shaking their heads and muttering, "Too bad!" They insist that filmed programs can never be as good as live staff. They will come as a surprise to Lucille and Desi Arnaz. Their "I Love Lucy" is rated the number one program in the world of television. It will also shock Groucho Marx, whose quiz show is rated number three. And I can just hear the number two attraction in television — "Dragnet's" Jack Webb, saying, "These are not the facts, ma'am!"
