A brief statement was issued in response to inquiries about a New York Daily News story saying more than 1,800 secret documents. some dealing with the continental radar screen for atomic defense, still are missing from the Signal Corps laboratories at Monmouth: The Army statement said:

"The matter of allegedly lost classified documents at Ft. Mon-mouth has been under investigation for some time. No information had been developed to substantiate the allegations attributed to former Capt. Benjamin Sheehan in recent press accounts

The Daily News said some of the documents disappeared as long ago as early 1952
