**Teamsters Union Moves to Absorb Longshoremen**  
WASHINGTON — The big AFL Teamsters union moved Thursday to absorb the International Longshoremen's Assn. which was ousted by the AFL.  
The move could lead to an early clash between Teamsters' President Dave Beck and AFL President George Meany.  
The executive board of the 1,300,000-member Teamsters organization, the AFL's largest union, authorized a committee of five vice presidents to explore affiliation with the 60,000-member I.L.A.  
New York leaders of the I.L.A. have already voted in favor of joining the Teamsters.
