14 Weeks in Session	414 Bills Passed by Both Houses
1177 Bills Introduced	99 Bills Passed This Week

Over half the 1,177 bills introduced in the Oregon Legislature have been disposed of as the legislators near the 100th day of their session at the Capitol.

At the end of their 14th week Saturday, the legislators had tabled 201 bills in committees and had passed 414 of the other bills in both House and Senate.

Last week was one of the busiest for final bill action, as 99 bills were sent to the governor.

Appropriations and major laws which received final legislative action last week included:

- SB 58 — Strengthens tax law provisions for State Tax Commission proceedings to assist assessors in discovering omitted property or correctness of assessments.
- SB 138 — Makes legal use of radar devices to detect speed of vehicles and use such as basis for arrests.
- SB 148 — Creates position of deputy corporations commissioner.
- SB 179 — Forbids sale of liquor to anyone under age 21.
- SB 244 — Makes it a crime and sets penalties for writing bank checks without sufficient funds in bank.
- SB 425 — Provides for county and state welfare officials' investigations into public assistance cases; subpoena of witnesses authorized.
- SB 473 — Authorizes State Board of Control to discontinue flax operation at State Prison if it doesn't make money.
- SB 477 — Appropriates \$2,426,140 for National Guard and \$200,000 for armory construction and maintenance.
- HB 40 — Redefines true cash value for tax purposes, to base it on current market value, starting in 1961.
- HB 104 — Provides stiffer penalties for narcotics peddlers, including life imprisonment for second offense in causing drug addiction.
- HB 224 — Makes confidential the case histories of state institution inmates.
- HB 434 — Limits damages collectible under libel law if libel is unintentional and a retraction is published.
- HB 494 — Places utilities and building rental firms under state corporate excise tax.
- HB 581 — Appropriates \$286,000 for completing and furnishing new building at Oregon State Hospital.
- HB 610 — Appropriates \$7,500

for participation in Council of State Governments and \$4,200 for Commission of Uniform State Laws.

- HB 611 — Appropriates \$1,921,500 for State Tuberculosis Hospital and \$1,085,560 for Eastern Oregon State Hospital.
- HB 612 — Appropriates \$8,036,000 for State Hospital and \$3,719,469 for Eastern Oregon State Hospital.
- HB 613 — Appropriates \$299,018 for State School for Blind and \$880,488 for State School for Deaf.
- HB 614 — Appropriates \$476,982 for State Library and archives.
- HB 615 — Appropriates \$85,009 for expenses of public utilities commissioner.
- HB 616 — Appropriates \$629,898 for finance and administration department.
- HB 617 — Appropriates \$22,596 for Willamette River Basin Commission.
- HB 618 — Appropriates \$209,289 for State Treasury department and \$4,600 for State Blind Commission.
- HB 619 — Appropriates \$178,011 for state executive department and \$3,835 for Capitol Planning Commission.
- HB 622 — Appropriates \$50,000 for architectural and landscape planning by Capitol Planning Commission.
- HB 624 — Appropriates \$13,500 for Oregon Museum of Science and Industry.
- HB 625 — Appropriates \$791,056 for University State Tuberculosis Hospital.
- HB 626 — Appropriates \$170,660 for State Board of Control.
- HB 627 — Appropriates \$45,000 for Oregon Historical Society.
- HB 628 — Appropriates \$292,669 for Commission for the Blind.
- HB 629 — Appropriates \$282,870 for expenses of Commission for Blind industries, rehabilitation, and prevention departments.
- HB 631 — Appropriates \$9,560 for Klamath River Commission.

Unfavorable weather did not ruin all the bloom, and the educational tables of named varieties, carries as many blooms as in former years.

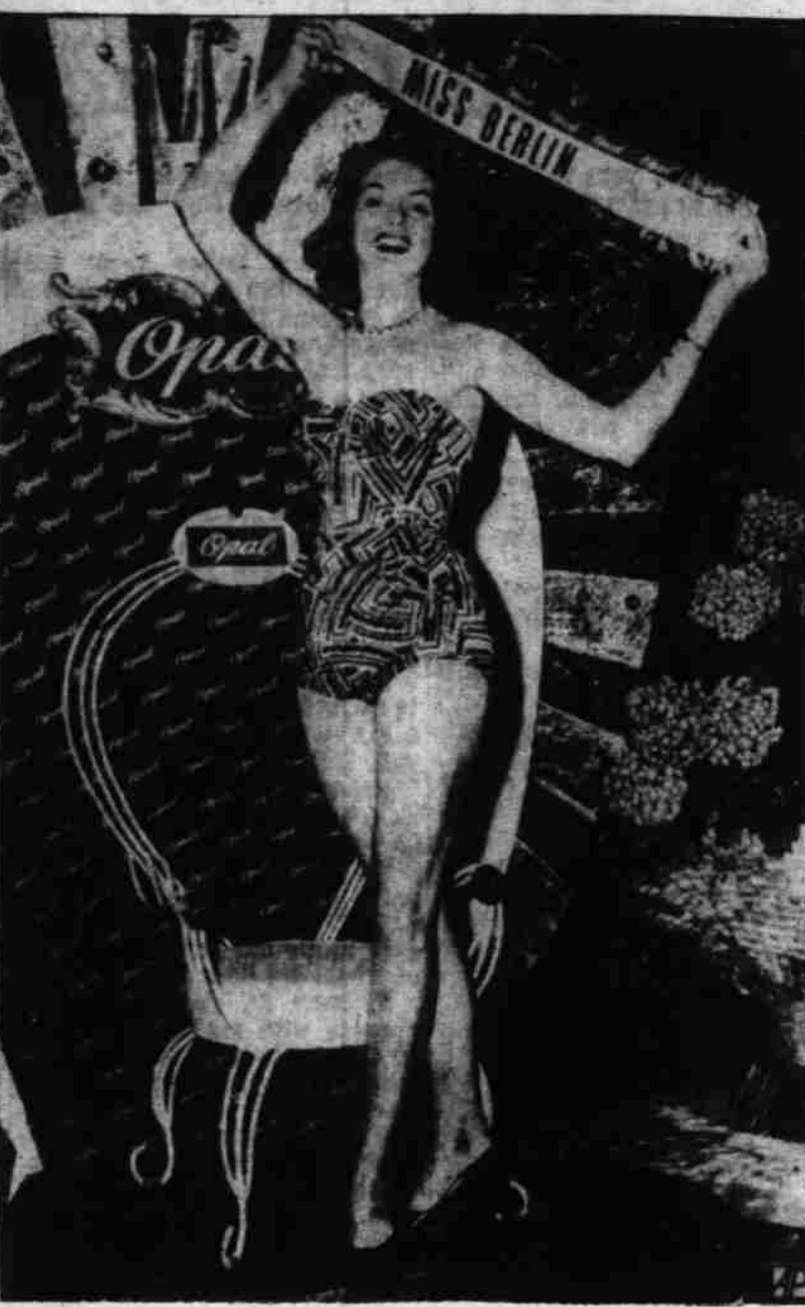

2 Boys Die In Old Icebox

LOS ANGELES (UP) — Two young boys were found suffocated Friday night in an abandoned icebox stored in an empty shed, sheriff's deputies reported.

The victims were Albert Arebalo, 8, and David Anthony Fennessy. The parents of the boys started a search for them Friday afternoon after the youngsters failed to return home.

Sheriff's deputies joined the hunt and discovered the icebox in the shed. Both boys were huddled inside. They had been dead about five hours, deputies said.

The owner of the shed, John Richardson, 26, told officers he stored the icebox in the shed about six months ago.

Middle East Pact Worry Soviet Union

MOSCOW (UP) — Soviet Russia threatened Saturday to raise before the United Nations the issues of American and British "pressure" in the Near East and the Middle East.

The Soviet declaration was made at a press conference at the Foreign Ministry.

It referred especially to the Turkish-Pakistan Alliance of 1954 and the new pact which links Turkey and Iraq.

The Soviet declaration on the Near and Middle East demanded that the United States and Britain stop their alleged "pressure."

Russia's stand, the declaration said, is made to defend "the interests of peace" in the Near and Middle East.

Nehru Urges Bandung Talks Skip Formosa

BANDUNG, Indonesia (U) — India's Prime Minister Nehru proposed Saturday night that the conference of 29 Asian and African countries talk generally about world peace and economic conditions — and not about details like Formosa.

Nehru and Red China's Premier Chou En-Lai are the two dominating figures of the conference which opens Monday. But Nehru will have the stronger voice in charting the course the discussions will take.

India, Pakistan, Burma, Ceylon and Indonesia are the conference's sponsoring powers. They will huddle in a key meeting Sunday to decide on what subjects should be up for discussion.

Arriving Saturday night, Nehru called for talks on "general principles rather than specific problems." Formosa, he said, was a specific problem — "a controversial issue which I imagine should hardly be discussed at this conference."

The Prime Minister said India believed the delegates, representing three-fifths of the world's population, should consider (1) the question of peace in the world, (2) economic conditions in backward Asian and African nations and (3) other general issues.

As Nehru spoke to newsmen here, Chou remained overnight in Jakarta, 75 miles away, where he received a noisy welcome at the closely guarded airport on his arrival from Rangoon, Burma. More than 5,000 Indonesian Chinese cheered and waved Red China's flag.

It will be in a 200 by 250-foot building in the Gateway Shopping Center near N.E. 99th Ave. and Halsey St. With parking area, the store will occupy five acres of the 18-acre center.

Already planned for the center are a big food store, 20 specialty shops and a bank branch.
