to beat the mark of 21.9 set by John McCall of Gervais in 1952, and Scio's Novak made it a double by pushing the shot 44' 10 1/2" to drop the old mark of 43' 5" notched by Herb Romey of Gates in 1954.

Although defending state 440 dash champion Allan Vail of Gates didn't match his district record of 53.3 in his specialty Thursday, the husky from up the canyon did smash the 220-yard dash mark with a romp of 23.2 during the day. Del Kessler of the Deaf School had the old mark of 23.6.

Miller Claude Meyers of Jefferson missed tying the four-lapper record of 4:47 by one-tenth of a second in the B division, but turned in a double win by also taking the 880.

The individual star of the day, however, was North Salem's Jim Norval. All this little swiftie did was take first in the 100, 220 and broad jump for 30 points, and then run the leadoff for the Vikings' winning relay team for 2 1/2 more points. It was a whopping day for him.

Other North Salem winners were Bill Kaufman in the 440, Del Funk in the low hurdles, Jim

Whitmore, who tied with South Salem's Darrell Ponsford in the high jump, and Jim Backstrand in the javelin.

Ponsford was South Salem's only winner.

Cascade's Ken Martin took the 880, and he was a Viking a year ago.

South Salem's Bob Griffin in the discus, Serra's Bruce McKay in the high and low hurdles, Stayton's Darrel Gohl in the shot, North Marion's Jack Berkey in the broad jump, Gervais' Gary Williams in the javelin, South Salem's Ed Keech in the pole vault and Neal Scheidel in the 440, North Salem's Del Funk in the 100 and Walt Craycroft in the 880, Silverton's Ray Shepard in the mile and Serra's Don Endres in the 220 had seconds, and qualified for the state meet. So did Woodburn's relay team.

All first and second place winners qualified for Corvallis.

St. Paul's Berhorst didn't quite match Gates' Vail for individual B honor, but he tried. Vail had first in the 220, 440 and broad jump, while Berhorst had first in the low hurdles and pole vault, and ran anchor on the winning relay team. Scio's Novak did match Vail, scoring first in the shot, discus and javelin.
