U.S. Signs Agreement To Share Atom Data With Britain, Canada

WASHINGTON — The United States Wednesday signed agreements with Great Britain and Canada to exchange atomic information "for mutual defense purposes."

President Eisenhower pledged as the four-way pact was signed at the White House that the United States would give "unremitting cooperation" in seeking permanent peace through the atom.

Silver Salmon Fleet in Action

ASTORIA (UP) — One of the world's largest fishing fleets Wednesday went into action off Astoria to fish for silver salmon. Season for trollers opened Wednesday and will continue until October.

The State Department announced texts of the defense accords would be made public in London, Ottawa and Washington. It declined to discuss the terms at this time, although at Ottawa the Canadian House of Commons was told the United States would supply information on defense against atomic and hydrogen bomb attacks.

Britain, Canada and Belgium already have participated in Western development of atomic energy. The President and officials of each nation participated in the signing ceremony at the White House. Similar arrangements have been completed with 17 other countries. All provide for give and take in research on peaceful applications of atomic energy — for power, medical treatment and the like.

Such mutual cooperation was authorized by last year's congressional revision of U.S. atomic energy legislation. The President said these agreements "lengthen the reach of cooperation among us looking toward the civil uses of atomic energy."

No exchange of information on military uses of the atom is provided, but both classified and unclassified data may be traded on peaceful applications. The United States will furnish some atomic materials. In addition, a separate White House statement said the transfer of "equipment devices" under prudent safeguard would be possible.

Portland Charged to Burned Mill

PORTLAND — A Federal Trade Commission hearing has been called for Aug. 16 at Brownsville, Ore., on a charge that the Brownsville Woolen Mills mislabeled some of its blankets before they destroyed the mill March 1.

Chester A. Page, owner, said some low-quality blankets were involved. Specifications called for 25 per cent virgin wool and 75 per cent woolen grade, he said, but added that the plant may have received a batch of woolen grade containing more than the usual percentage of cotton threads and seams.

"We thought we had satisfied the inspector as to how we were making blankets. Then this notice came out of a clear sky. We try to follow label requirements," Page said.
