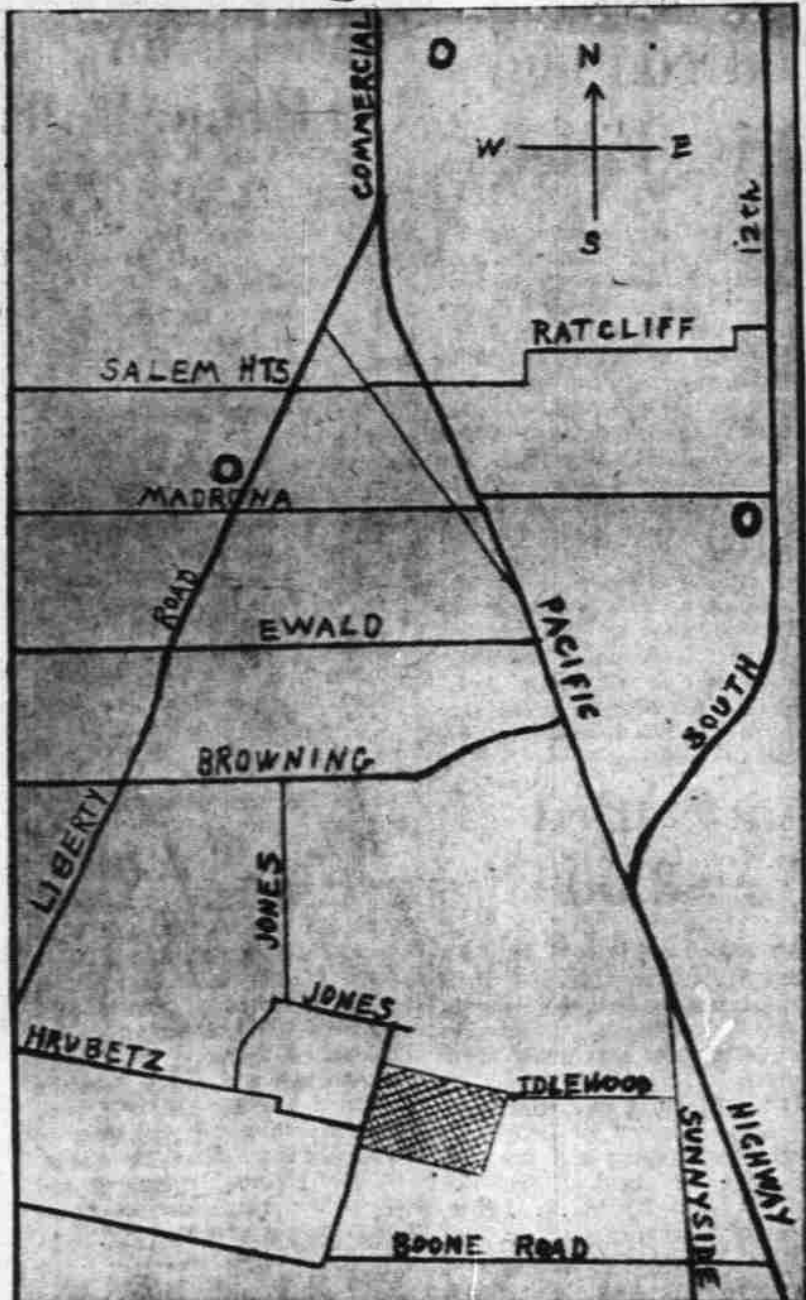

Cobalt Bomb Treats Cancer

NEW YORK (U) — Montefiore Hospital has installed a new radioactive cobalt bomb for treating deep-seated cancer. It has more radioactive energy than all the known concentrated radium in the world.

The bomb, which produces powerful X-rays, is the equivalent of 44 million dollars worth of radium. It was made in the atomic pile at Chalk River, Canada, and cost the hospital \$25,600.

One Killed in Crash of Jet

SAVANNAH, Ga. (UP)—One pilot was killed and another escaped with injuries Monday when both bailed out of their F86 jet fighter planes during a thunderstorm.
