Argentina's Dictator Asks Political Truce

BUENOS AIRES (UP)—President Juan D. Peron called upon his enemies for a political truce Tuesday.

In a bitter, 10-minute speech, Peron castigated rumor mongers and the authors of the bloody but short-lived revolt which flared against his regime on June 16. But he concluded:

"I ask all comrades for a truce in the political struggle.

"God grant that this hard lesson serve us all. God grant that our bitter enemies lay down hates and vengeance, convinced of their impotence against the people."

It was Peron's first public utterance since June 23. Advance announcement that he would make it had raised tension in this unsettled capital to the highest point since the revolt.

Peron said the situation had returned to normal in Buenos Aires and that the rest of the country also was quiet.

Seek Legal Order

"The people and responsible political forces are tranquil," he said. "All are convinced of the uselessness of violence and are inspired by the wish to reaffirm the legal order."

He said some civilians participated in the Navy-led revolt but that no political parties, as such, were involved.

The address was Peron's first since June 23. It came amid increasing indications that a settlement of the months-long dispute between church and state may be near.

Announcement of the speech created speculation also about Peron's own position. In his last address 12 days ago, the president said it was only his "great will-power and sense of duty" that kept him from resigning.

Hope to Return

The breaking of the silence coincided with reports from Vatican City that two Roman Catholic priests expelled from Argentina by Peron hope to return to their posts soon.

This development, it was made known, would be followed by the lifting of the Vatican decree under which, Peron and all others connected with the expulsion were excommunicated.

Observers believed a reversal of the decree might lead to further relaxation of strained relations between the government and the Roman Catholic Church in Argentina.

Pair Deported

The expelled priests, Monsignors Manuel Tato and Ramon Carlos Novos, were deported by Peron at the time of the abortive revolt by navy and air force units June 16 during the bitter dissension between the state and the Catholics.

Indications that the government and the church may be patching up their differences came Sunday when state officials and leading church dignitaries. There was no disclosure of the subjects discussed.

The fact that former Interior Minister Angel G. Borlenghi had left for the United States was made known for the first time Monday by the Peronista morning newspaper, El Lider.

Borlenghi generally had been regarded as the spearhead of the anti-clerical faction in the former Peron government that resigned after the revolt. He also was considered one of Peron's most trusted men.

Reliable western sources said Red police about two weeks ago opened their campaign with raids, middle-of-the-night arrests, personal and automobile identification checks and long interrogation of suspected anti-government persons.

Premier Andras Hegedus was reported missing after a disagreement with Hungarian Communist strongman Matyas Rakosi. The Premier took office only last April when Premier Imre Nagy was ousted in line with the changed policy the Kremlin.

The independent Vienna newspaper Neuer Kurier said reports it had received from the Hungarian capital of Budapest in the past 48 hours indicated a state of semi-emergency existed in Hungary.

The newspaper said the police were forced to take strong action because of the growing undercurrent of rebellion. Western sources said they could not confirm the newspaper reports, but that police in the past two weeks have been conducting a terror campaign in which even the British and American legations were under surveillance.
