## Noted Pastor To Speak at Salem Church

One of the most popular preachers in America will be guest speaker at morning and evening services the next two Sundays at the Calvary Baptist Church.

Dr. J. Whitcomb Brougner Sr., though long past the usual retiring age, is still in demand for his platform and pulpit ministry. He has been pastor of some of the largest Baptist churches in America, serving churches in Boston, Portland, Los Angeles and Oakland.

He has served as president of the American Baptist Convention and held many responsible positions of national leadership among Baptists. He is well known as a humorist whose messages are full of life. He is often called the "Will Rogers of the pulpit," a title which is particularly apt because he and the famous humorist were close friends. When Will Rogers met this untimely death in a plane accident, Dr. Brougner was called upon to conduct the funeral service.

Dr. Brougner will speak Sunday morning on the subject "A Man's Greatest Ambition" and at the 7:30 evening hour his topic will be "Four Looks and A Choice."
