

Schmidt Files Suit For Divorce From Remarried Spouse

RED BLUFF, Calif. — Dan Schmidt filed suit for divorce Friday, and his wife, Una, indicated through her attorney she would fight for custody of their 2½ year old son, Danny.

The 22-year-old airman, who returned to the United States last week after 32 months in Red China prison, filed divorce papers at Red Bluff Friday asking custody of the son and charging Una, who says she married a 21-year-old logger, Alford Fine, in the belief Schmidt was dead, with being an "unfit mother." He also charged "extreme cruelty."

Jeep Vacuums City Streets in Nation's Capital

WASHINGTON — The Washington city fathers are now using a home-made jeep-mounted vacuum cleaning device to help pick up curb-side trash.

The six-inch hose of the vacuum device picks up debris in a 12 to 16 inch radius. The impeller fan which powers it is so strong that it chews cans to bits, grinds bottles into sand and reduces anything else within range to a fine pulp which is collected in bags in the jeep.

Navy Reveals High Altitude Rocket Tests

WASHINGTON — The Navy reported Friday it has fired rockets 17 miles into the upper air above a jet plane from which they were launched at 30,000 feet.

The Navy said the tests took place this week at the Chincoteague, Va., Air Station. It described the plane-launched rockets as a "practical and inexpensive tool" for research observations.

During this week's tests only cosmic ray studies were made, the Navy said. But it added that the rockets fired vertically from high-flying air craft will be used later to measure upper air temperatures and densities, ozone concentrations and high altitude winds.

The testing system, known as "Rockair," is an extension of the balloons floating at an altitude of about 70,000 feet.

The Office of Naval Research said the plane-rocket method had an advantage over the balloon system in that the former can be launched in a controlled direction by the airplane pilot.

Negro Named Governor of Virgin Isles

Under former Gov. Earl Warren, now chief justice of the United States, Gordon served as a member of the state's Board of Prison Terms and Paroles.

Army to Take Enlistments in New Reserve

WASHINGTON — The Army announced Friday that enlistments will be accepted immediately for the new six-year reserve training program.

The announcement also said the Army will be ready to take volunteers for the six months training plus 7½ years in active reserves phase of the new program in the "immediate future." Officials have said this means about Oct. 1.

Six-year enlistments directly into the reserves are open to youths of 17 and over who have not received a draft induction notice. Those accepted must serve two years in the standby reserve.

Enlistees will be permitted to serve their two years on active duty anytime they choose within the six-year period.
