Secretary of State John Foster Dulles and Foreign Secretary Harold MacMillan, at a 90-minute meeting with Roland de Margerie of France, were said also to have agreed to coordinate their policies more closely in Mideastern affairs.

Each has the common aim of ousting Kremlin influence from the area. De Margerie sat in the absence of Foreign Minister Antoine Pinay, who was in Paris for a vital Assembly session.

Plane Limp Back to Coast

TRAVIS AIR FORCE BASE, Calif. (AP) — A military transport plane carrying 66 passengers and crewmen returned safely here Saturday after two engines failed 250 miles at sea on a flight to Honolulu.

The four-engine C97 strato-freighter was escorted in to its Travis landing by two air rescue center planes. Two coast guard patrol boats and a Navy ship also were alerted in case Capt. H. J. Gahn, the pilot, had been forced to ditch.

Youth Admits Fatal Shooting

EUGENE (AP) — Larry Gaserude, 14, admitted Saturday that he accidentally shot his 10-year-old brother, Jerry, while hunting Friday. Coroner Fred Buell reported. The younger boy died of a .22 caliber bullet wound in his temple shortly after he arrived at a hospital here.

At first Larry said Jerry accidentally shot himself while the two played at home with another brother, Tommy, 3, Buell said. Later their father, Ralph Gaserude, notified Buell that Larry had admitted firing the fatal shot accidentally.

Body Found In Car Trunk In Washington

YAKIMA (AP) — The father and sister of a Shafter, Calif., man were on their way to Yakima Saturday night with the grim prospect of finding that he was the person who had been stabbed to death and stuffed in the trunk of his car here several days ago.

The man believed to be the victim of the knife-slashing was Hollis Boone, 39. His description matched that of the knife victim and the car was registered to him.

The automobile was towed to a garage Friday night after being left near the fairgrounds for several days. Blood stains were noticed on the trunk Saturday and the body, clad only in a pair of G. I. trousers, was doubled up inside.

An autopsy disclosed that a stab wound penetrated the man's heart and that he had been dead about three days.

A brother-in-law of Boone, Weldon Tye, of Shafter, said Boone had called him early this week from Yakima and requested money to return home. Nothing further was heard of him.

Fire Knocks Out Eugene Boiler Plant

EUGENE (AP) — Fire knocked out the plant that provides heat for most of Eugene's downtown buildings Saturday morning in snow and sub-freezing weather.

Another source of heat was found quickly. The Eugene Fruit Growers cannery steam plant was connected to the system.

Firemen fought eight hours to control the blaze that broke out in the Central Heating Co. boiler plant at 1:25 a.m.

Firemen kept the flames from spreading, but icing conditions hampered their efforts at quick control. A large crowd gathered at the scene, despite the cold.

A. C. Dixon, principal owner of the plant, estimated damage at \$15,000. He said the plant would be out of operation some time. The cause of the fire was not determined at once.

Hunters Walk From Woods

WOODLAND, Wash. (AP) — Two hunters who failed to return from a trip into the upper Lewis River country and for whom a search had been started walked out unharmed late Saturday.

They were Larry Knight, 25, and his brother Jimmy, 17. They joined another party of hunters after spending the night in the woods.
