## Silverton Teacher to Accept Agricultural Post in India

**SILVERTON**—Leonard Hudson, instructor of vocational agriculture at Silverton for the past 17 years, will leave around the holiday season for Washington D. C. to accept an appointment to Nepal, India, as Agricultural Livestock Advisor.

The appointment comes through the International Cooperative Administration and is for the usual two-year period.

The vacancy in the Silverton schools will be filled at once, Milton Baum, high school principal said Sunday. The board and the faculty has been advised of the appointment for several weeks, Baum said, but have been awaiting definite orders. Through the state department of vocational education, Recommendations are on hand for a new vocational agricultural instructor for Silverton, Baum added. Hudson has been in hopes, members of the board said, that the orders would come in sufficient time to give him an opportunity to help the new instructor with details of taking over in mid-term.

Going with Mr. Hudson will be his bride, Miss Eustelle Bauman, to whom he will be married in Mt. Angel on Thanksgiving Day. Miss Bauman is a teacher in St. Mary's grade school in Mt. Angel.

The two will take two weeks orientation in Washington, D.C., starting Jan. 5 before they leave by air for Kathmandu, Nepal, India.

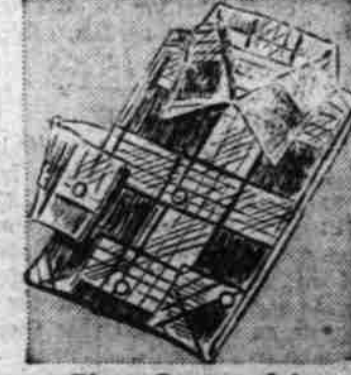
