Market Rally Fails to Hold

NEW YORK (U)—The stock market failed in an early rally bid Friday and then sold off persistently in hits third straight decline. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks was off \$1.20 at \$172.20. That's in the neighborhood of the level of last November when the market was recovering strongly from the great fall brought on by news of the President's heart attack. The industrial component of the average was off \$3.40, rails were down 40 cents, and utilities slipped 20 cents. There were 1,197 individual issues traded of which 239 advanced and 712 declined with 16 new highs and 23 new lows for 1955-56. Volume came to 2,430,000 shares as compared with 2,800,000 shares Thursday.
