## Fruitland EUB Church Slates Revival Meet

## Film Message To Describe Israel Tour

Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock a public film presentation on developments in Israel will be given at the Salem YWCA by Casimir Lanowick, a Christian Zionist and the editor of "The Jews in the News" magazine.

Lanowick has just returned from a trip to the Land of Promise, where he spent four months. He will give an eye-witness account of his observations.

Editor Lanowick has presented about 400 illustrated lectures on Israel in the United States, Canada and England during the past four years and is currently on a three-month West Coast tour. He expects to return to Israel again in March.

"Israel As I Saw It," will be shown in the main floor auditorium of the YWCA. Admission is free. This feature has been arranged by a group of local Christian friends of Israel.

## Church Plans Educational Program Hike

FOUR CORNERS—An expanded educational program is being planned by Trinity Methodist Church at Four Corners. Beginning Sunday an extended session of the Church School will be held during the 11 o'clock worship. ## YWCA Plans Study Series On Religions

Tuesday evening Dr. and Mrs. Robert F. Anderson will be leaders for the subject of "Prayer," the third in the YWCA series. Resources for Making Religion Real, Emphasized in this presentation will be the practicing of prayer in the family group, and the necessity and use of prayer from the medical viewpoint.

Residents of Salem and vicinity are invited to register for the new term of Bible studies and instructions to be given at the interdenominational Capital Bible Training School. The new term begins on Monday evening with registration at 6:45 and classes from 7:15 to 9:15.

Eight courses are being offered by the school this semester of 13 consecutive Monday nights and each registrant can take two of the courses offered.

A study of the provision God has made for man's need of salvation will be taught by the Rev. John B. Turnbull. Dr. Lloyd F. Anderson, president of the school, will teach on the Books of first and second Peter. The Rev. Alex H. Sauerwein, dean of the school, who has recently moved to Tacoma, Wash., will be returning each week to teach two courses, one in the study of Genesis and the other a brief survey of each of the New Testament books.

The Life of Christ as presented in the Gospel of Matthew will be taught by the Rev. Elmer East, and the Rev. Robert Goertz will give an exposition of the Acts of the Apostles. Miss Ruth Backus, Portland missionary worker, will teach a class in the methods of approaching and winning Jews to Christ. A study of the major false cults is directed by the Rev. Elmer Hiebert.

All the classes are now being held each Monday night in the educational rooms of First Baptist church.

## State Parks Unit Outlines Study Areas

REEDSPORT—William M. Tugman, chairman of the advisory committee assigned by Gov. Paul Patterson to make a special study of state parks administration and organization, is emphasizing that the state park hearings Feb. 24 and 25 are to be devoted to problems of policy, not detailed projects.

Tugman said that many of the letters which are coming to him indicate a desire to discuss specific park projects, details of land acquisition of improvement which are not really in the province of the Advisory Committee.

He added, "Our committee really has just one main problem to study—whether our state parks should remain under the jurisdiction of the Oregon State Highway Commission, or whether they should be transferred to the management of an entirely independent board or commission."

"Our reports and recommendations will be transmitted to the governor, the interim highway committee of the Oregon Legislature and to the State Highway Commission as a guide to possible legislation."

## Willamette Flood Control Repairs Due

WASHINGTON (AP)—Rep. Norblad (R-Ore) said Friday he has been assured Army Engineers will work along the Willamette River repair and restore all flood control works along the Willamette River which were damaged by recent floods. They will do so whether the work was a private or federal project, he said.
