**Arabs Against** West Sending **Armed Forces** 

CAIRO, Egypt IM -- In the wake of the Eden-Eisenhower talks in Washington, the weight of Arab opinion appears strongly opposed to having Western forces sent in to patrol Palestine.

But behind the scenes and off

The air-armed fleet could, in their view, stand by offshore as a mute warning with potential force against aggression by either Arabs or Israelis.

Arab officials have been sparing with comment in view of the general nature of the Eiden-Eisenhower communique references to peace-keeping between the Middle East antagonists.

Most of the scant comment has not agreed to by the Arabs.


