Freight Rate Hike Under Study by ICC

WASHINGTON (AP) — The Interstate Commerce Commission (ICC) Wednesday took a projected half-billion-dollar-a-year railroad freight rate increase under consideration, after an agreement was reached to postpone the scheduled effective date from Feb. 25 to March 7.

Three days of oral argument over what action the ICC should take produced a long string of shipper protests and numerous demands for "hold-downs" on specific commodities described as unable to absorb the flat 7 per cent increase proposed by the rail industry.

Magnuson Bill Urges Safer Aviation Laws

WASHINGTON (AP) — A bill designed to provide safer aviation was offered Wednesday by Sen. Magnuson (D-Wash.). The bill, introduced at the request of the Commerce Department, would provide for civil penalties for failure of ground crews and certain manufacturers to comply with certificates issued by the Civil Aeronautics Administration (CAA).
