GM Caravan Plans Parade Through City

Progress—dressed up in red, white and silver—will roll into Salem Tuesday as the General Motors Parade of Progress arrives in preparation for a five-day free showing at Bush Pasture Park. The caravan of 44 Futuriners, trucks and passenger cars will arrive at Waldo Street and Route 99

at 2 p.m. from Corvallis at 2 p.m. Civic officials and local GM representatives will be picked up at that point for the parade through the city. Led by a police escort, the procession will follow Liberty Street, to Center Street, turn east on Center to High Street, and then proceed out High directly to the show site on the baseball field at Bush Park. The traveling circus of science will open to the public at 7 p.m. Wednesday. It will remain open until 10 p.m. opening night, and will be open from 2 to 10 p.m. daily thereafter through Sunday, April 15.

A 40-minute stage show will be presented six times daily in the Aerodrome tent on week days and eight times on Saturday and Sunday. Exhibits housed in the 12 giant Futuriners are in operation at all times. Stage shows and exhibits dramatically depict the cavalcade of progress, showing how scientific research and engineering have helped improve our standard of living, and telling of the even greater things they may do in the future.

Medford Man To Head Area 20-30 Clubs

A two-day convention of Oregon 20-30 clubs concluded Sunday at the Hotel Marion with election of top officers and re-emphasis of plans for an expansion campaign in the state. John Watkins, Medford, was re-elected district governor of the organization and Ralph Jackson, Salem, was named lieutenant governor.

Some 70 members from seven clubs present at the Sunday session voted to hold next year's convention at Gearhart. The 1957 meet will be sponsored jointly by the Salem and McMinnville clubs. Norman Morrison, Sacramento, Calif., Northwest area director, again spoke on the great expansion possibilities offered in Oregon. Aim of 20-30 officials is establishment of clubs in all cities of 5,000 population or above.

AURORA — An estimated \$4,000 damage resulted Sunday when fire broke out in a house rented by Mr. and Mrs. J. M. Paulsen on Aurora Route 1, firemen reported. House owner is R. H. Bassett, Salem.

The flames completely destroyed a second-floor closet full of clothes and also caused damage to attic and roof. Discovered by Mrs. Paulsen about 4:15 p.m., the fire apparently started from a downstairs wood heater.

The flames were fought by men and equipment from Aurora, Donald and Woodburn fire departments. Damage reportedly was covered by insurance.

Mrs. Cook Rites Tuesday

The Rev. Lowell Holte will officiate at funeral services for Mrs. Sally Kelley Cook, Tuesday, at 1:30 p.m. in Virgil T. Golden Chapel.

Mrs. Cook died Saturday at the age of 79 in a local hospital following a stroke last Tuesday. She was born at Athens, Ga., Sept. 21, 1877, and moved with her family to Missouri while still a child. Her first husband, Charles Tildon Kelley died in 1920. The year they moved to Salem. In 1935 she married Edward R. Cook, who survives. She was the mother of five former all-state Salem High School athletes, and a member of First Christian Church and the American War Mothers.
