

Mock Political Convention Hears State Demo Leader

State Democratic Chairman Howard Morgan delivered a political pep talk to some 300 delegates and state Democratic party leaders at Willamette University's Democratic Mock Convention banquet held Saturday evening in the Marion Hotel.

Many leaders of tomorrow will come from convention delegations, Attorney General Robert Y. Thornton said in remarks preceding the Morgan talk.

In afternoon sessions the delegates adopted a platform calling for federal aid to education, Alaska and Hawaii statehood, atoms for peace and a watered-down civil rights plank. It wasn't watered down enough for the Southern delegates, though, and they walked out of the convention after a rules-blocked attempt at a filibuster.

Noted Nature Lover Dies In Accident

SPOKANE — Willie Willey, 72, who gained national attention for his habit of going summer and winter wearing only khaki shorts and a green eyeshade, was found dead Saturday afternoon in his car which had run off a residential street and hit a tree.

The bearded nature lover died of a punctured heart, the coroner said. Several ribs were broken in the crash and one entered Willey's heart and another his lungs, he said.

Almost as well known as his attire was Willey's use of old model automobiles as a home for himself and his scores of pets. Willey was severely burned when his car-home was destroyed by fire April 6 and just Friday a local car dealer presented him with the title to another used auto.

He was driving the gift car when he died.

Willey, who started discarding clothes as he battled for good health as a young man, had been the subject of several Associated Press feature stories. And just a few years ago he appeared at a Los Angeles sportsmen's show.
