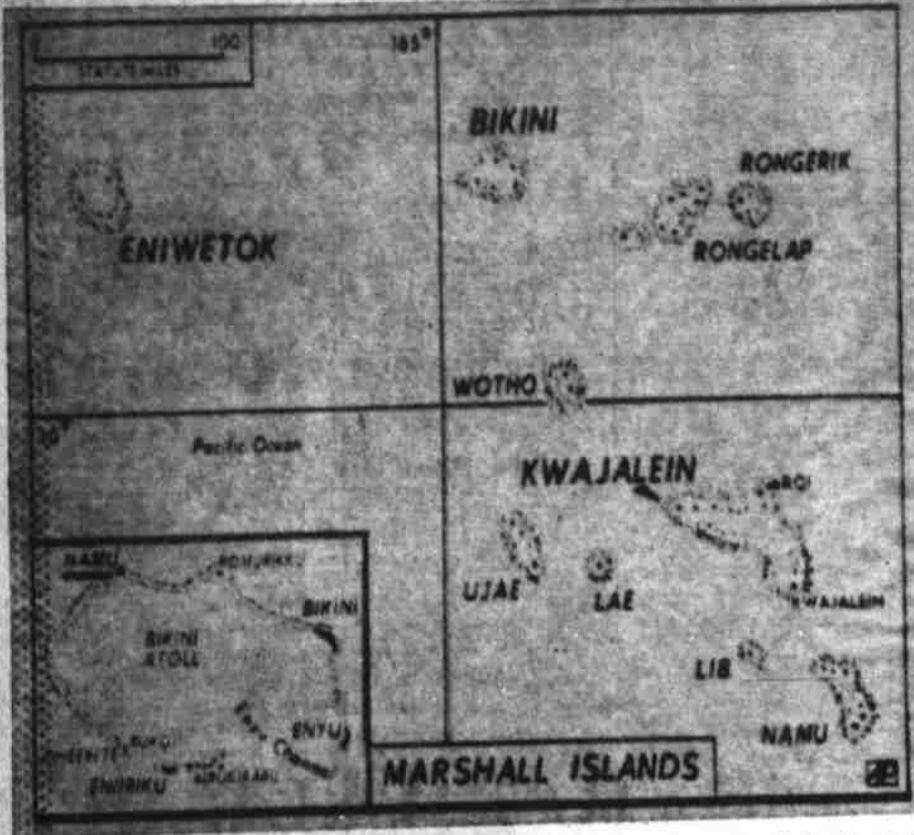


Map Locates H-Bomb Air Drop



H-Bomb Target WASHINGTON — Enlarged inset sector on map of the Marshall Islands underlines little Namu Island, on the northwest edge of the Bikini atoll, where America's first planeborne hydrogen bomb was exploded Sunday. The test shot in the Pacific atomic proving grounds was dropped from a B52 jet bomber and detonated at a planned altitude of 10,000 feet above Namu. (AP Wirephoto).

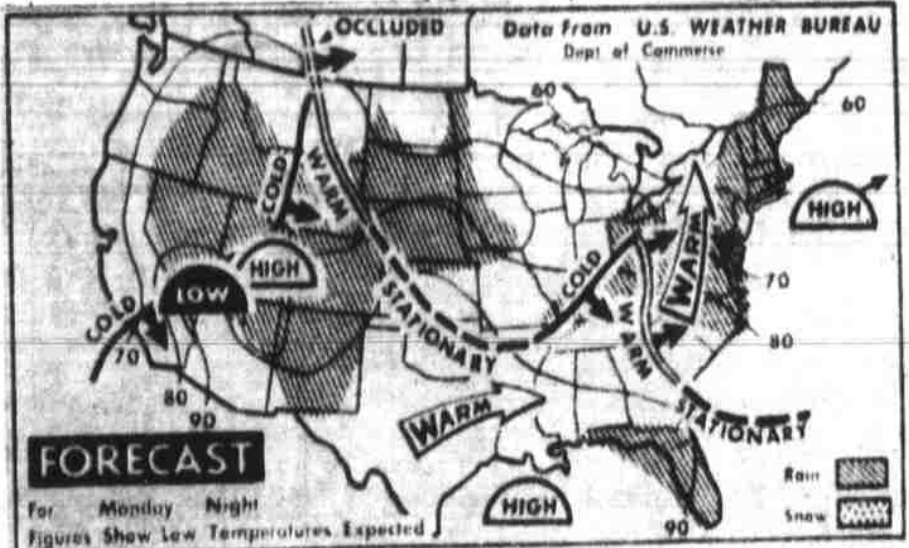
