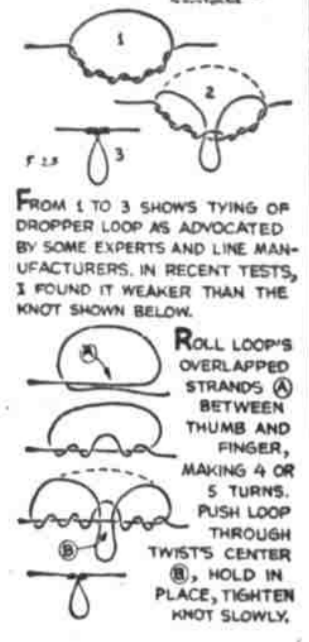

**Keller Leads Batting Race**

Webfoot Ace Rapping At High .488 Clip

OREGON STATE COLLEGE, Corvallis—(Special)—Oregon's veteran shortstop Johnny Keller continued to hold the northern division batting lead as the league swung into its final week of a tion. In figures released by Bill Neland, division statistician, Keller was hitting at a luscious .488 clip, 20 points better than runnerup Bill Rich of league-leading Washington State.

Oregon's outfielder - pitcher, Terry Maddox, held a wide margin in the run-batted-in department with 21, seven more than Oregon State's Dan Lovejoy. A third Web-foot, Jim Pihler, paced the two-base hit department with 5, while teammate Jim Pingree shared the triple lead with OSC's Jack Bowen at 2.

Idaho's Ron Braden ran his stolen base total to 10, all but three of his teams' total thefts.

Three pitchers sported unblemished records, with WSC's Ron Aiken in front with a 3-0 mark. Oregon's Don Lane and OSC's Al Guidotti have posted the most wins with four each, and each have recorded one set back. Lane leads the division with a nifty 1.14 earned run average.

The figures help show why WSC and Oregon are battling for the championship. Oregon fronts the league in hitting at .294, with Washington State in second spot. The Cougars have the top fielding mark, while the Ducks are second there.

The league will finish play this week with Oregon State and Oregon meeting at Corvallis and Eugene, while Washington State and Idaho will play three times—twice at Moscow and once at Pullman.
