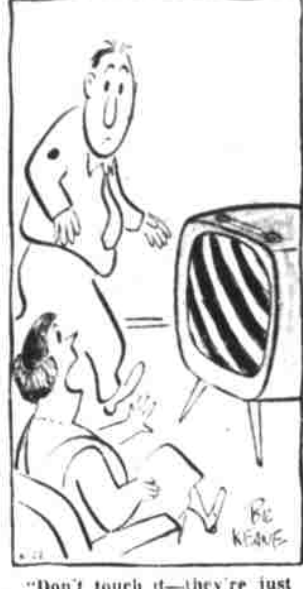

Playwright Miller, Marilyn 'Plan Marriage by July 13'

WASHINGTON — Playwright Arthur Miller said Thursday he is going to marry film star Marilyn Monroe before July 13.

Miller let the news out in talking with reporters at a short break in a hearing at which he was being questioned by the House Committee on Un-American Activities.

The 40-year-old playwright said he had been too busy recently to fix the date of their marriage, but "I hope to settle it all right soon."

He noted that she is leaving for London July 13 to make a movie, and declared: "When she goes to London she will go as Mrs. Miller."

Miller said he has filed a passport application and if the passport comes through he will go to London with Miss Monroe.

He has been having passport troubles with the State Department, a matter that came up with the committee hearing today.

Miss Monroe has previously been married to former New York Yankee baseball star Joe DiMaggio. Their marriage ended in divorce.

Miller received a divorce June 11 at Reno from Mary Grace Slatery of New York. They were married in the 1930s while both were students at the University of Michigan.
