

### Accurate Shot Saves Life of FBI Operative

LOS ANGELES (AP)—A quick, accurate shot by an aide was credited Wednesday with saving the life of the local chief of the FBI as he grappled with a bank robbery suspect he'd just dragged from a closet.

The suspect had a loaded .32 automatic leveled at the head of John Malone when agent Ed Pievack fired, sending a bullet through the man's gun arm and into his chest.

The action occurred Tuesday at a home in suburban Watts where FBI agents had closed in to capture two men accused of robbing a Security-First National Bank branch of \$1,600 and of kidnaping a woman during their getaway.

"I'll kill all of you," James G. Evans, 22, screamed as Malone pulled him from the closet. Pievack fired as the two struggled.

Maxie Brown, 21, charged with Evans with suspicion of robbery, came meekly from his hiding place under a bed.

Evans was hospitalized in serious condition.

Officers said the men, recent arrivals from Philadelphia, entered the bank with drawn pistols, lined some 30 patrons and employees against a wall, and fled with three sacks of money.

After crashing their own car during the getaway, they ran to an intersection and forced Mrs. Della Harris, who was parking her car, to drive them across town. They released her later unharmed.

Officers traced them to the Watts address from cards in a wallet left in the crashed car.

### Ava Gardner Denies Plan For Marriage

LONDON (AP)—Actress Ava Gardner Wednesday denied published reports she plans to marry Porfirio Rubirosa after obtaining a divorce from Frank Sinatra.

The beautiful movie star, who is making a film in Britain, said in a statement:

"There is absolutely no truth in the report I am to marry Porfirio Rubirosa."

"I met him once in Madrid and dined with him in company with others one evening in Paris. These are the only two occasions when I have seen Mr. Rubirosa."

The marriage report was published yesterday in a New York paper. Rubirosa, international playboy and former Dominican diplomat, was last married to dime store heiress Barbara Hutton.

### U.S. Rejects Soviet Protest

WIESBADEN, Germany (AP)—The U.S. Air Force Wednesday rejected a Soviet protest alleging that American military planes flew over Soviet soil this month.

The U.S. Air Force's European headquarters issued a one-sentence statement denying the Soviet charges made in a protest to Washington last night.

"No aircraft assigned to the command of the U.S. Air Force in Europe violated Soviet or satellite territory," the statement said.

BRIGHTON, England (AP)—A surgeon estimated Wednesday that the medical profession had cured cancer in 250,000 people now walking the streets of Britain.


The figure was given by Dr. A. Dickson Wright of St. Mary's Hospital, London, treasurer of the Imperial Cancer Research Fund.
