

Administration Big Guns Carry Foreign Aid Fight to Congress

WASHINGTON — Secretary of State Dulles, pleading for more foreign aid money than the house voted, said Thursday, "It would be a disaster" to relax now in the face of the threat of world Communism.

Dulles and Adm. Arthur W. Radford, chairman of the joint chiefs of staff, went before the Senate Appropriations committee one day after the House voted to withhold Foreign Aid Appropriations to \$3,600,000,000.

Radford testified that the "serious reductions" voted by the House, from President Eisenhower's request for \$4,000,000,000, would "involve serious jeopardy to our security position and might well lead to a further

weakening of the defense efforts of our allies."

Closed Session

The Dulles-Radford testimony was reported to newsmen by the committee after they appeared in a closed session.

The most that the administration can hope for is an increase in the foreign aid appropriation to \$4,014,000,000, the ceiling set in authorization legislation that has already passed Congress.

Whatever appropriation the Senate votes for would have to be adjusted with the \$3,600,000,000 the House voted yesterday.

The summary of testimony showed that Dulles told the Senate committee any appropriation substantially below the four-billion-dollar authorized ceiling

would be interpreted abroad as meaning that Congress believed the danger of Communist aggression has passed.

Can't Assume Victory

He said that while developments in the world picture have been favorable, "it would be a disaster if we were now to sit back and assume that victory has been won."

"It might seem easy to cut dollar figures," he said, "but these have to be translated into people and places, and it is impossible to select any area supported by this mutual security program that this national could sacrifice without the gravest danger to our own security."

"The cuts voted by the House . . . could have a serious psychological effect upon the nations of the free world who would relax their own great efforts if they felt the United States did not consider further efforts necessary."

Diplomat Denies Shaking Fist at Publisher's Widow

BANGKOK, Thailand, (U. S. S. Ambassador Max Bishop said Thursday, "I never shook my fist in any lady's face in my life."

He expressed amazement in an interview at published accounts of a talk he had with Mrs. Robert R. McCormick, widow of the late publisher of the Chicago Tribune, at a dinner party in the home of British Ambassador Berkeley F. Gage here May 21.

Back from a round-the-world tour, Mrs. McCormick said in Chicago Tuesday Bishop had threatened to seize her passport because she wanted to enter Red China as a press observer.

"He put his fist in my face, then said that he controlled half of the U. S. Senate and that he would have my passport withdrawn if I continued to try to visit Communist China," she said.

"Mostly Social"

The ambassador, a man who gestures as he speaks, commented that he recalled the after-dinner talk was "mostly just social conversation."

And he differed with Mrs. McCormick's statement that he had brought up the passport subject abruptly by saying, "I understand you're trying to get into Red China . . . why?"

"Her desire to go to Communist China was mentioned by her, I believe, for until she told me I had no way of knowing she wanted to go," Bishop said.

Passports Not Valid

He explained that American passports are not valid for travel in Communist China and added that he would advise against her going because it would be hazardous.
