

County's Air Raid Warning Network To Get Test Friday

The first county-wide test of Marion County's air raid warning network will be conducted next Friday as part of a nation-wide civil defense test, County civil defense director Wallace S. Wharton said Friday. The test has been named Operation Alert 1956.

A three-minute warning, consisting of intermittent siren blasts will be given by fire departments throughout the county. The big steam whistle at the Oregon Pulp and Paper Company will sound simultaneously with sirens of the city's five fire stations.
