

President Expected to Order Some Cuts in Armed Forces

WASHINGTON—Administration officials said Saturday President Eisenhower probably will order some reduction in the total level of U. S. armed forces after present studies by the joint chiefs of staff are completed.

Any cuts made in the present strength of 3,000,000 men will be within the limits of U. S. defense requirements, it was said. The informants emphasized that Eisenhower is anxious to promote a trend toward smaller military forces as one means of improving the prospects for agreement with

Russia on a global arms reduction and control program. A new sense of urgency about the need to reach some initial agreement on disarmament in the near future now is apparent in high administration quarters.

Officials said the atomic arms race is approaching a "point of no return" and unless it can be checked before that point a disarmament agreement with Russia may become impossible.

The reduction in U. S. armed forces would be in a sense, at least, a response to Russia's announcement several weeks ago of a determination to cut its man-

power strength by 1,200,000 men, down to a total of about 3,000 or less.

At the same time, officials said that cutbacks would reflect increased confidence in the prospects for peace due to Russia's changed behavior, as well as the hard military reality that increasing reliance on nuclear weapons has made it possible for all the powers to reassess their manpower requirements.
