**Jewish Mayor Of Dublin to Visit America**  
 DUBLIN, Ireland (AP)—Robert Briscoe, the first Jewish Lord Mayor of Dublin, said Tuesday night he will visit America in the fall and again next spring, when he will take the salute at New York's famed St. Patrick's Day parade.  
 The first trip will be strictly unofficial, Briscoe told newsmen. "I shall be calling on friends in Boston, Chicago, Cincinnati, Cleveland and—perhaps—San Francisco," he said.  
 The second trip will be the invitation of New York's Mayor Robert F. Wagner.  
 Briscoe, 61, was elected to the city's top civic post last month—the first time a Jew has ever been mayor of this predominantly Catholic city.  
 But it wasn't his first public office. The bustling bow-tied businessman has been a member of the Dail (parliament) for the last 30 years.  
 During what the Irish describe as the "troubles" he was a staff officer of the revolutionary commander, Michael Collins.
