

Florida Klan Denounced High Court Before Flaming Cross

LAKELAND, Fla. (AP) — Hooded Ku Klux Klansmen of Florida denounced integration and the U.S. Supreme Court Saturday night in a civic pasture eerily lit by a flaming cross and festoons of light bulbs.

At the same time, a Lakeland Negro congregation joined their pastor in prayers for the Holy spirit to move among Klansmen holding their first state rally in many years.

About 250 Klansmen clustered around speakers — all unidentified by name — who charged Florida's state government to maintain segregation of the races in Florida public schools. Klan leaders said several hundred more members were in a crowd packed six and seven deep along a rope strung in front of the fiery cross.

Attempt to Walk Subway Track Brings 11-Hour Ordeal of Pain
