**Mt. Angel Grain Shipments Relieve Storage Pressure**

Two cars of grain were loaded at Mt. Angel Monday afternoon to help relieve the last few days' pressure in the grain storage facilities at the Mt. Angel Farmers Union Warehouse. Grain elevators were filled and there had been no dumping space for farmers' grains Monday morning. By mid-afternoon, dumping at the warehouse began again.

**Church Hikes Lead in Idaho Over Taylor**

BOISE, Idaho — Official tabulation of the votes cast in last Tuesday's Idaho primary election added slightly Monday to the slim lead held by youthful Frank Church of Boise in the tight race for the Democratic Senatorial nomination.

With official returns in from three-fourths of Idaho's 833 precincts and with unofficial reports included from all but one of the remainder, the vote was:

Church, 27,969; Farmer Sen. Glen H. Taylor, 27,895.

The official state canvass is set for next Saturday.

Taylor, who served as Democratic Senator for Idaho for one term but ran as the Progressive Party nominee for Vice President in 1948, said Monday that if the official canvass shows he is the loser he will demand a recount.

Church, an attorney, has had no comment.

**Climb Seen in Mill Demand On Electricity**

PORTLAND — Bonneville Power Administrator William A. Pearl predicted Monday that demand for electric power by lumber, pulp, paper, composition board and plywood mills in the Pacific Northwest will increase about 185 per cent by 1960.

Pearl, speaking at the Forest Industries Forum luncheon here, said Northwest forest industries are the second heaviest users of electric energy. He said that last year they consumed kilowatt hours amounting to the entire output of Bonneville Dam.

in the arctic weather experienced in the valley this past winter, more barley was planted in spring than in many years. Most of the grain will be in shelter by the end of this week, although some spring oats, which Kirsch said "will have to take a back seat so far as storage is concerned," is yet to be harvested in the Mt. Angel area.

**Car Supply Close**

C. M. Brownell, manager of the Valley Farmers Coop at Silverton, said that it had been "nip and tuck" with the car supply at his plant so far this year. He added, however, "that so far we've had the cars as we needed them—but sometimes it didn't look as if we would." Some 330 tons of wheat, oats and barley have been coming in daily at the Silverton plant. The grain crops are running about the same in the Silverton area as last year, Brownell thought.

Leon French of Derry Co-op in Polk County said that cars had not been "too plentiful," but also stated that not too much "damage had been done by shortage" so far. He believed fully 75 per cent of the 1956 grain crop was now harvested and didn't anticipate much trouble from car shortage now. Some 450 tons of barley and wheat were being received daily yet at the Derry plant.

**No Shipments**

Pacific Grain Company, also at Derry station in Polk County, was not shipping but was able to store all received. Joe Miller, warehouse manager said. Some 350 to 400 tons were received daily and Miller expected the "heavy" part of the season to wind up with this week.

**Excess Fat Brings Army Court-Martial**

FT. CARSON, Colo. — Officers and men of the Eighth Infantry Division are getting trim waistlines before shipping out for their next duty assignment which will take them to Germany this fall.

Maj. Gen. Thomas M. Watlington, fort and division commander, said Monday punitive action—including court-martial—is being taken against a "handful" of men who have failed to peel off excess fat as ordered. The program to bring overweight soldiers down to standard was announced by the General a month ago.

Gen. Watlington said about 1,200 men in his command of 25,000 were found overweight when he started his drive under an order from the army chief of staff. Of that number, the General said, 800 have lost weight to bring them down to scale and about 400 are still in the reducing-by-diet program.

Gen. Watlington estimated that "less than 20 men" have been brought before court-martial boards or punished by unit commanders for failure to comply with orders. Punishment can range from discharge from service to reduction of one rank or fines.
