

Adlai Sounds Confident of Victory Nov. 6

BOSTON, Oct. 29 (AP)—Adlai Stevenson today combined an attack on President Eisenhower's stand on the hydrogen bomb with a confident prediction of victory Nov. 6.

The Democratic presidential candidate again hit hard at Eisenhower's attitude on halting the testing of the H-bombs.

"As in so many other fields," Stevenson said, "the President simply offers another do-nothing solution."

And in a special conference phone call to his Democratic state chairmen, he predicted the winner will be determined in this final week of the campaign.

"This election is close," Stevenson said. "And no matter what the public opinion polls may say, my trip around the country this week has convinced me that we are going to win."

Big Day for Adlai
It was a big day for Stevenson as he:

Put out his statement on the hydrogen bomb.

Held folksy family style national television interview.

Rode in a motorcade through downtown Boston, where he got a rousing reception that seemed all the bigger because the streets are so narrow the crowds were forced right up to his car.

Means Victory

Told Massachusetts Democratic bigwigs, in a luncheon speech, that the crowds he has been attracting this past week is an "exciting" experience that he feels means victory. Deputy Police Supt. James J. Hickey estimated the midday throng at 100,000.

Phoned his state chairmen to give them a pep talk in which he said:

"Despite the Republican press, our own private polls show that we have convinced the farmer, the small businessman, the workman—the great majority of Americans—that their best interests are served by the Democratic party."

Biggest Upset

Stevenson likened this campaign to 1948, when Harry Truman beat New York Gov. Thomas E. Dewey in one of the biggest upsets in political history.

But it was the hydrogen bomb—and what this nation should do with the monster—that kept bobbing up in Stevenson's remarks throughout the day.

It began with his statement, 2,000-words long, on why he thinks Eisenhower's viewpoint, that the tests must be continued, is wrong.

And it was intended as an answer to Eisenhower's so-called government paper on the same subject a week ago. Stevenson peppered his statement with such phrases as these:

"The net effect of Eisenhower's argument is one of hopeless defeatism."

Claims Misstatement

"The President presented his documents to America and the world as an official statement, but it appears to be no more than a campaign pamphlet. And even as a political paper it is remarkable for misstatements and distortions."

"The President seems insensitive to the danger of radioactive fallout from H-bomb explosions."

Stevenson repeated an argument that he has used before, that Russia soon may overtake us in H-bomb production.

"What then?" he asked. "The President has no answer. My own answer is that when we reach a point where terror cancels out terror we must turn to diplomacy and new ideas to find a way toward nonnuclear peace."

2 KILLED BY LANDMINE

NICOSIA, Cyprus, Oct. 29 (AP)—Two British soldiers were killed today by a landmine which blew up their truck at Stroumbi, a village in the western part of Cyprus. They were the 67th and 68th Britons to die by violence on this island since the Greek underground began its campaign for union with Greece 19 months ago.
