

# Mervyn LeRoy Top Movie Director for 30 Years

HOLLYWOOD, Nov. 3 (AP)—Mervyn LeRoy, most durable of all Hollywood boy wonders, this year celebrates 30 years as a top movie director.

Mervyn of the movies no longer is a boy. He's 55 and there's a distinguished grey around the temples. But the enthusiasm that made him a boy wonder when he made "Little Caesar" is still there.

"I start every picture like it's my first. When I lose my enthusiasm, no one will ask me to quit. I'll just go back to selling newspapers in San Francisco and retire gracefully from Hollywood," he comments.
