## Republican Chiefs at Odds Over Need for 'New Label'

NEW YORK, Feb. 12 (AP)—The president of the National Republican Club, a New York City group, politically but firmly gave the back of his hand today to conservative GOP critics of Eisenhower Republicanism.

"We disagree most emphatically with them... the brand of Republicanism that the nation wants is Eisenhower Republicanism," said club President Daniel J. Riesner in a prepared speech at an annual Lincoln Day dinner honoring Henry Cabot Lodge Jr., U.S. ambassador to the United Nations. To go along with the conservatives, he added, would insure that the GOP "slips back to a party of secondary importance."

## British Hedge 'Free Trade' Commitment

PARIS, Feb. 12 (AP)—The economic ministers of 17 nations today pledged support of a plan to turn non-Communist Europe into one vast free trade zone of 300 million people. It is potentially the world's richest market.

Sir David Eccles of Britain called for a treaty by July to launch the plan to tear down tariffs. But he made one reservation that threatened to delay the program.

The chairman of Britain's Board of Trade told the Organization for Economic Cooperation only industrial goods should be included. That would leave tariffs on agricultural products.

Make Objection

Economic Minister Jens Otto Krag of Denmark objected strenuously. Krag said Denmark as an agricultural country could not join under such conditions. Portugal, Italy and Greece took the same view.

Krag conceded Britain's commitments to import agricultural products from Commonwealth nations created a special case. In brief, tariff-free agricultural products from Europe might undercut Commonwealth exports.

Commerce Minister Gunnar Lange of Sweden and Finance Minister Paul Ramadier of France saw hopes of a compromise on the question.

The zone would embrace Austria, Belgium, Denmark, France, West Germany, Greece, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Norway, Portugal, Sweden, Switzerland, Turkey and Britain.

Over 15 Years

Tariffs in the 17 nations would be eliminated gradually over a period of about 15 years until all would be able to buy and sell freely among member countries.

Words of both support and caution came from the United States and Canada. They sent observers but neither would be members of the zone.

"We want to be sure," said U.S. observer John B. Hollister, "that the removal of trade barriers within the area will not involve increased restrictions or discrimination against outside countries."

L. D. Wilgress of Canada endorsed Hollister's warning.

The European market is important to both the United States and Canada.

"Modern GOP"

In an obvious allusion to President Eisenhower's recent use of the phrase "modern Republicanism," Simpson said:

"The modern Republicanism in which I believe is the Republicanism of Lincoln and Taft (the late Sen. Robert A. Taft of Ohio). There isn't a single Republican in America who needs to apologize for what his party basically stands for."

In a speech prepared for a Lincoln Day meeting of the Hamilton County GOP Central Committee, Simpson said that "irrespective of any new labels placed on Republican party activities, I have been unable to detect anything that is wrong with the Republicanism" of Taft.

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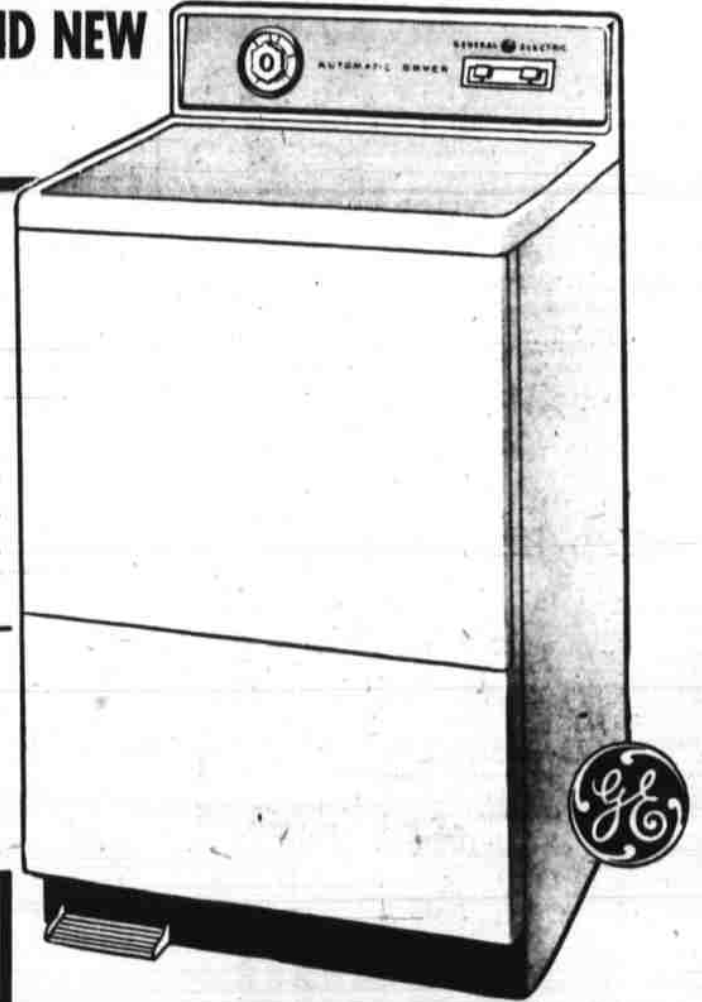
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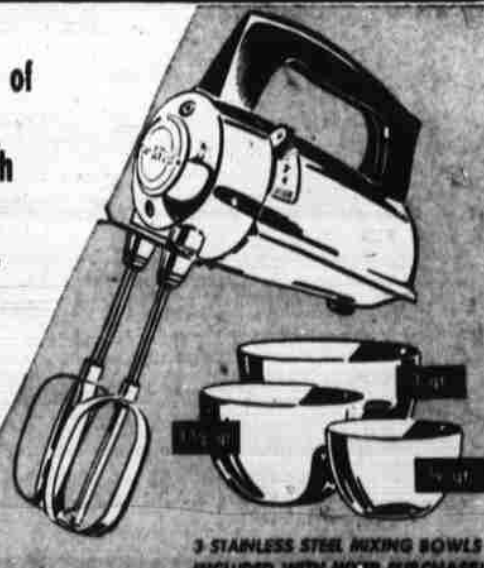
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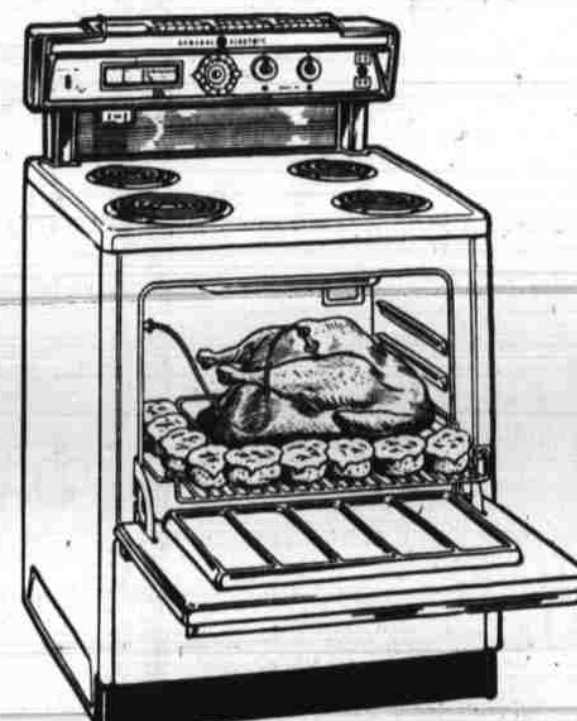
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
