South Salem Bows In 'Sudden Death'

MILWAUKIE, Feb. 12 (Special)—South Salem and Milwaukie battled through regulation play and three overtimes in a 47-45 overtime basketball game here tonight until a lay-in by Wally Flanner gave Milwaukie a 47-45 victory.

South's Saxons had the game all but wrapped up with just 42 seconds to go as they held a 43-38 lead, but Milwaukie roared back to tie it up 43-43 to force the game into extra action.

Milwaukie's Lee Yeast sent his team into the overtime by canning a free throw after the final gun, but he missed his second shot which would have meant victory for the Mustangs.

In the first overtime, the Saxons' Keith Burres hit on a jump shot to send Salem into a 43-43 lead. But Con Tekke, who scored 17 points for the night, matched the feat with 26 seconds left and the team went into another three minutes of play.

South Salem monopolized the ball in the early part of the second overtime. Milwaukie finally took over and held the ball in an attempt to get a shot just before the end of the overtime but none of the Mustangs could get the ball away.

MIAMI BEACH, Fla., Feb. 12 (AP)—Joe Brown's right hand and Wallace (Bud) Smith's legs are the main factors in tomorrow night's 15-round lightweight title match in which Brown is a topheavy favorite to retain the crown he took from Smith in August.

Chris Dundee, co-promoter of the International Boxing Club, expects a sellout crowd of 4,000 and a \$20,000 gross gate at the Miami Beach auditorium which will be housing its first championship fight.

Network (ABC) coverage on radio and TV will carry the fight at 7 p.m. PST.

When Brown, 30, stripped Smith, 27, of his title, Aug. 24 at New Orleans the battle was scored by rounds and resulted in a split decision. Under Miami Beach rules, scoring will be by the "Must 10" point system in which the winner of a round gets 10 points and the loser 9, 8 and so on.

As the fighters are signed to 30-30 contracts for the match, each will get about \$5,000 from the gate and another \$9,000 from TV or a total purse close to \$14,000. (Cont. page 10, col. 8)
