MEMPHIS, Tenn., March 5 (AP)—A big DC7 airliner cruising at 14,000 feet cast a propeller today, slashing off the cabin top above the heads of 41 passengers.

Britain Plans More Nuclear Power Sites

LONDON, March 5 (AP)—Lord Mills, minister of power, said today Britain has decided to build 16 more nuclear power stations. Three stations were ordered when the government set up the atomic energy program in 1955.

By 1965, Lord Mills told the House of Lords, Britain hopes to have 19 stations in operation along the coasts, providing about a quarter of the electricity the nation needs.

He estimated the cost over nine years at about \$4,088,000,000. Engineers calculated the plants will save 18 million tons of coal a year and relieve Britain of the heavy financial burden of buying foreign fuel, chiefly oil.

Holt Equipment Plant Reduced to 2-Day Work Week

INDEPENDENCE, Ore., March 5.—Some 60 men employed by Holt Equipment Co. in Independence were reduced to a two-day work week today. They had been working five days a week.

Company President Francis Holt said the reduction was due to a materials shortage. He expects the plant to return to normal operation in two or three weeks.

U.S. Teachers In Poland Possible Under Trade Plan

WARSAW, March 5 (AP)—Representatives of the Rockefeller Foundation said Monday they expect to see American professors teaching in Polish universities soon under an educational exchange program.

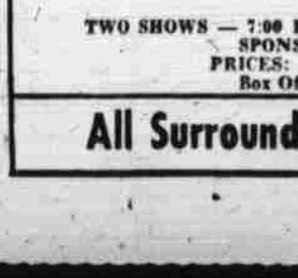

DUBLIN, Ireland, March 5 (AP)—Eamon de Valera's chances of a political comeback in the Irish Republic he helped create grew tonight. There was a larger-than-expected turnout of voters in the national election.

The election was held amid widespread unemployment and economic distress, and rousing cries for reviving the fight against Britain to bring the six counties of Northern Ireland into the Irish Republic. The voting was peaceful.

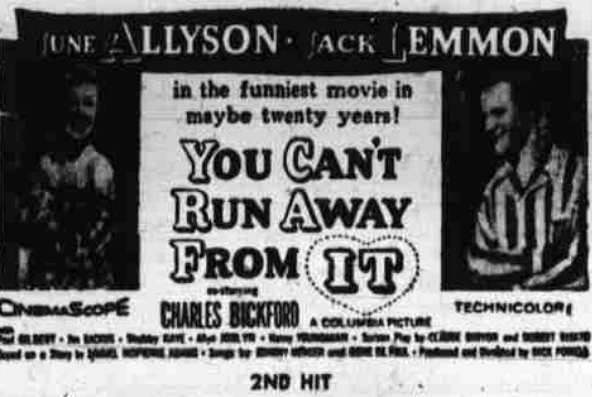
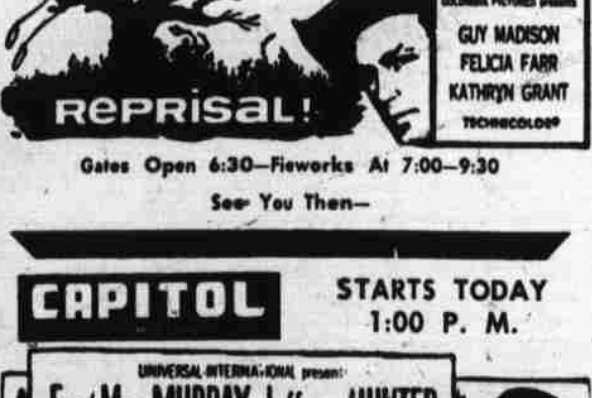
