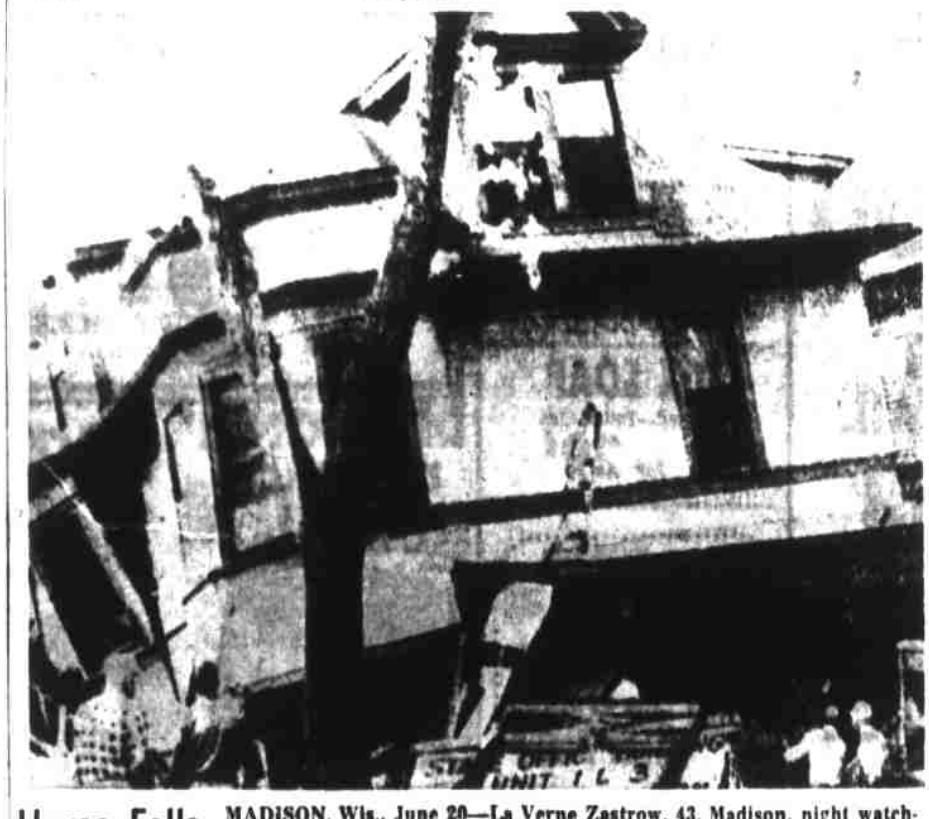
Runaway Romance Ends
