

Jet Crashes Into Massachusetts Homes, Set 6 Afire; 2 Fliers Die

WORCESTER, Mass., July 18 (AP)—A jet trainer plane, spinning out of control, crashed and exploded on a quiet tree-lined residential street today, scattering wreckage which set six houses afire and killed the two fliers aboard.

Search for 24-Year-Old Grave Ends

A search for a 24-year-old grave in Salem ended successfully Wednesday for John P. Grindol of Battle Creek, Mich., when he located his brother's unmarked grave at Reicrest Memorial Cemetery.

On his first visit to the West Coast, Grindol stopped in Salem with the specific purpose of finding the burial place of his brother, Paul, who was killed here Sept. 17, 1953, when a house he was moving fell on him and crushed him.

With all of his family located in the Midwest, none of the members were able to attend the funeral and Grindol had wondered about the grave for over 23 years until, retired, he had an opportunity to come to Oregon.

His search started at the courthouse where he located probate records of his brother's estate from which he learned the funeral services were handled by Clough-Barrick Funeral Home. From there it was easy, as the cemetery, although it does not use temporary markers, keeps a map of all plots on the grounds.

Before leaving Salem, Grindol contacted the Veterans' Administration office to make application for a government marker for the grave. His brother was a 19-year veteran of the Navy.

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Air-to-Air Atomic Rockets Guarding U.S.; Test Today

ATOMIC TEST SITE, Nev., July 18 (AP)—The U. S. Air Defense Command is armed with atomic air-to-air rockets of the type scheduled to be test fired here tomorrow, 14. Gen. J. H. Atkinson said today.

Two of the houses were badly damaged despite the efforts of occupants to control the flames until firefighters arrived.

The plane was attached to the 133rd Air National Guard at Greiner Air Force Base, Manchester, N.H. It was one of a flight of three on a training mission.

Oregon City To California Dash Planned

OREGON CITY, July 18 (AP)—Duncan Seymour said today he wants to find out if Indians can cover as much distance—as fast—as they did in the old days.

In order to find out, Seymour said he plans to run from here to Los Angeles.

The 38-year-old Seymour, who said he is a Blackfoot Indian from Calgary, Alta., said that he won't run quite the entire 1,000 miles or so.

He said he plans to take buses to get through the larger towns on the route. Seymour said he didn't know when he would start the trip.

And Seymour said he will stay in hotels at night.

The entire trip probably will take about 24 days, and he said he hopes to make up to 50 miles a day if conditions are right.

In the old days, he said, "an Indian used to cover that same distance all the time and think nothing of it."

Seymour plans to run along Highway 99 from here to about San Francisco, and then switch to Highway 101, the coastal route.

He said that for a conditioning exercise, he walked to here from Calgary.

The test rocket will be fired from an F-100 Scorpion jet fighter flying the lead position in a formation of three.

The rocket will not be armed until moments before it is launched from an altitude of more than 15,000 feet and that it will be detonated more than 15 miles from New York, where observers will be stationed.

Superintendent William Nevins has told the Vancouver Tourist Association he will provide a scarlet-coated officer to pose for a party of American travel agents who will tour the city in September.

Said Tom Cox, assistant manager of the association, "We have been trying for years to achieve this because of the inquiries we get from Americans. This is great news."
