But today's star—he wants to be like the guy next door! That's laudable, say old-timers, but who pays money to watch the guy next door?

Not Bernie Schwartz, anyway. Bernie was the guy next door and found no magic in the role. Now he's movie idol Tony Curtis, and he's doing his best to recreate the high living of the '20s that prompted the phrase "gone Hollywood."

Tony, who costars with Burt Lancaster in "Sweet Smell of Success," earns almost as much as he spends, and he spends it in a manner that makes business agents wish they were file clerks again.
