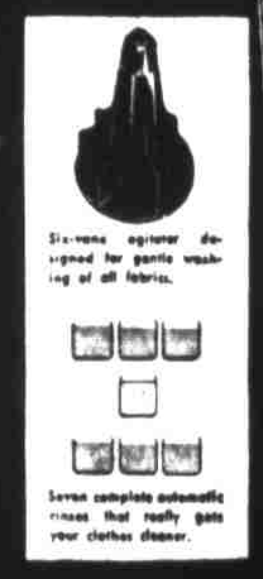

## Ike Rejects Jury Trial Clause

WASHINGTON, July 31 (AP) — President Eisenhower urged the Senate today to pass the civil rights bill quickly—and without a jury trial amendment.

"I support the bill as it now stands, earnestly, and I hope that it will be passed soon," the President told his news conference.

"That is my last word on civil rights," he added.

A sweeping jury trial amendment that would revise the general law in criminal contempt cases is now being debated by the Senate. Just when the senators would get around to voting on it was uncertain.

Sen. Knowland (R-Calif.) said he might try to force a vote on the issue this week.

Meanwhile, Senate leaders may succeed in laying aside the civil rights bill temporarily to get action on a number of appropriations measures and other legislation blocked by the long debate.

Blocked by Morse  
A unanimous consent agreement is needed to suspend the civil rights debate, Sen. Morse (D-Ore.) blocked such an agreement yesterday, but he said today he would have no objection to sidetracking civil rights temporarily if the agreement contained a debate limitation clause and fixed a time for a vote on the jury trial amendment.

Morse suggested a vote before or soon after Aug. 1, one week from tomorrow. There was no immediate indication whether Southern Democrats opposing the civil rights legislation would commit themselves to a specific voting time.

Knowland, the Senate Republican leader, told newsmen he would prefer a voting deadline of this week. He could force a vote by offering a motion to table the amendment. But he said he wouldn't do this without giving at least a day's advance notice.

Would Kill Amendment  
Adoption of a tabling motion would kill this particular amendment, but others could be offered. Eisenhower said today the mounting backing of legislative business in the Senate "is a very serious thing."

He pointed out the authorization for the Small Business Administration runs out tonight, for one thing, "so that 1,300 employees working there can continue to work only on request and without any assurance they will ever get paid, whatever, unless the authorization is continued."

On civil rights, the President said he believes the government should make certain that every citizen with a constitutional right to vote actually enjoys that right.

The pending bill would authorize the attorney general to apply for federal court injunctions against any violation or threatened violation of the voting rights of Negroes or other minority groups. Persons flouting the injunctions could be charged with contempt of court and tried by federal judges without a jury.

Also in Labor Cases  
The jury trial amendment would guarantee jury trials in all cases of criminal contempt. It would apply not only to civil rights injunctions but those in labor cases and all others.

In sustaining the right to vote, Eisenhower told the reporters, "We must sustain the power of federal judges in whose hands such cases would fall."

So I do not believe in an amendment to the (voting right) Section 4 of the bill," he continued. "I believe that we should preserve the traditional method in the federal judges for enforcing their orders."

The jury trial amendment is sponsored by Sen. O'Mahoney (D-Wyo.), Kefauver (D-Tenn.) and Church (D-Idaho). Senators supporting it and opposing it appear to be about evenly divided, so that a couple of votes either way may decide the issue.

Church said last night that he and Sen. Jackson (D-Wash.) will propose a change in the amendment to provide for setting up federal standards for jurors in all federal courts. State standards for choosing jurors would be bypassed in cases involving any federal law.

Church said the change would eliminate the possibility of excluding jurors because of race or color.

One argument opponents of the jury trial amendment have been using is that white juries in the South would not convict in cases involving voting rights of Negroes. Southerners dispute this bitterly.

In addition to providing for enforcement of voting rights, the pending bill would establish a commission to make a two-year study of civil rights problems and set up a civil rights division in the Justice Department. The bill was passed by the House June 18.
