

Building Permits at \$153,515

Ninety-two building permits for construction, totaling an estimated \$153,515, were issued in Salem during July, according to records in the city engineer's office.

During July 1956, the city issued 122 building permits, which totaled an estimated \$518,075.

Of the \$153,515, new construction accounted for \$102,050. Last year in July, \$301,695 represented new construction.

Of the 92 permits, 66 were for alterations or improvements, 21 were for new structures, 3 were for wrecking, and 1 was for house moving. In July 1956, the figures were: alterations, 89; new construction, 28; and wrecking, 5.

Largest permit this past July was to L. H. Periman for erection of a brick office building at an estimated \$40,000. Construction started last Friday and the building is expected to be ready by Oct. 1. The U. S. Bureau of Internal Revenue will take over most of the space.

On Wednesday, permits were issued to Dewey's Used Cars for alterations to their office and parts room at 3000 Market St., estimated cost \$1,700, and to H. T. Heaton for \$100 of home alterations at 820 Orchard Heights Rd.

Properties Reappraised In 8 Counties

Property reappraisals, originally sponsored by the State Tax Commission and now in progress in many parts of the state, have been completed in eight counties: the Harney, Jackson, Morrow, Wasco, Columbia and Clatsop.

Similar operations are in progress in 15 other counties with three slated to complete their work early in 1958. These three counties are Coos, Sherman and Tillamook.

Counties in which the property reappraisal operations have been completed in eight counties, the Harney, Jackson, Morrow, Wasco, Columbia and Clatsop.

Property appraisals are now in progress in Marion, Benton, Coos, Crook, Curry, Douglas, Hood River, Klamath, Lake, Lane, Malheur, Polk, Sherman, Tillamook and Washington. Deschutes County is under property reappraisal contract but little work has been accomplished there up to this time.

Total Bills at Legislature Hit 1,336

Measures introduced at the 1957 legislature number 1,306, of which 1,336 were bills, based on a report released by the legislative council here Wednesday.

Of the total of bills 630 were introduced in the House and 697 in the Senate. There were 170 other measures.

The House passed 467 bills and the Senate 246 bills. Gov. Robert D. Holmes signed 484 house bills and 343 senate bills. He vetoed three house bills and four senate bills.

There were 25 constitutional amendments introduced in the house and 20 in the senate. Five resolutions proposing constitutional amendments were approved in the house and six in the senate.

A total of 403 bills failed to pass both houses. The legislature's counsel office drafted 57.6 per cent of all bills introduced in the house and 39.6 per cent of those introduced in the senate.

Copies of the report were being sent to members of the legislature along with other persons interested in the session.

Political Group Women to Form

A women's auxiliary will be organized by the Marion County Committee on Political Education. It was decided Wednesday by the executive committee of the union sponsored organization.

Mrs. J. E. Paris, wife of a Salem union carpenter, was chosen temporary chairman. The women's organization would carry out such functions as urging all union members to register to vote, it was reported.

The plan for the new group was discussed with Mrs. Zoe Wilson of Portland, a state COPE officer. The executive committee met for luncheon at Randall's Chuck Wagon.

Feature Story Brings Sheriff Another Knife

Marion County Sheriff Denver Young had another knife to add to his sizable collection Wednesday as the result of a feature story which appeared in The Statesman last weekend.

The collection item was donated by a Salem woman who said she had received the knife from her brother in Africa several years ago and had never known what to do with it until she read the Statesman story. Sheriff Young said.

As for the sheriff, he was pleased to add the small tapering weapon sheathed in a polished wooden scabbard to his collection of some 45 knives gathered from various parts of the world.
