NEW YORK, Aug. 12 (AP)—Movie producer Boris Morros, 62, said today he had served the United States for 12 years as a counterespionage agent against the Soviet Union.

The Russian-born Hollywood figure, a naturalized American citizen, said the Soviets believed he was a spy for them but that actually he was making reports to the FBI on his encounters with the Russians.

He said that once while he was in Moscow, meeting top men of the Russian secret police, word questioning his loyalty to the Russian objectives was received in Moscow from Soviet sources in America.

One Village Retained by Rebel Chief

MANAMA, Bahrain, Aug. 12 (AP)—The white flag of the rebel Imam of Oman was reported flying over only one village today in central Oman today.

The red banner of the Sultan of Muscat and Oman was seen flying this afternoon at Bahkla Village, which has always been with the rebels, British officers said.

Secrecy Part of Rights Bill May Be Eliminated
WASHINGTON, Aug. 12 (AP)—House Republican Leader Martin (Mass.) raised the possibility today that a disputed secrecy provision in the civil rights bill could be eliminated if the measure is sent to Senate-House conference.

Under the bill, anyone who releases or uses in public without the consent of the commission evidence or testimony taken in the commission's closed-door sessions could be liable to a fine of up to \$1,000 or a jail term of up to one year. The provision has been interpreted by some to mean that newspapermen could be punished for using information about what went on at closed sessions of the commission.
