Salem YMCA Adds Youth Secretary

State May Get Flu Vaccine In September

PORTLAND, Aug. 16 (AP)—Oregon probably will receive no anti-Asian influenza vaccine before early September, acting state health officer Dr. Gordon Edwards said today. Edwards said 500,000 shots of the vaccine were released this week for national distribution, but none apparently will be sent to Oregon. The state probably will get its first supplies when some eight million other shots are made available early in September, he said. Edwards said that Oregon now has three cases of Asian influenza. The cases, he said, were mild, with fever, sore throat and headache, lasting three to five days. The vaccine is being distributed through regular commercial channels on a first-come, first-served basis, Edwards said.
