Beer Drivers Strike, Leave Area Facing Prospect of 'Dry Holiday'

Salem area residents may be facing a dry holiday unless 25 local beer drivers, who left their jobs Wednesday over a wage dispute, reach an agreement with the city's six beer distributors.

According to Ward Graham of Salem Teamsters Local 324, the men went on strike after distributors turned up their noses at a requested 19-cent-an-hour wage increase plus several fringe benefits.

The drivers declined an offer of a 12 1/2 percent pay raise, retroactive to May 15 with an additional 2 1/2 percent increase Jan. 1, Graham said.

Working under a one-year union contract that expired May 15, the truck drivers-sellers are now paid \$2.50 per hour with an added 18 cents for pension and \$10.40 monthly in a health and welfare fund. They also receive their uniforms, eight paid holidays per year, two weeks vacation after one year and three weeks after five years.

TEL AVIV, Israel, Aug. 28 (AP)—The Political Bureau of the Israeli Communist party, in a manifesto today, accuses the Ben-Gurion government and imperialist agents of planning to initiate a war against Syria.

Demanding a complete change in Israel's foreign policy, the Communist statement published in the Communist daily Kol Haam, said Israel could acquire for herself the same economic assistance and political sympathy of the Soviet Union which Syria has just acquired if she only conducts a policy of peace, nondependence and neutrality.

The Israeli Communist party has five deputies in the Parliament of 120 members.
