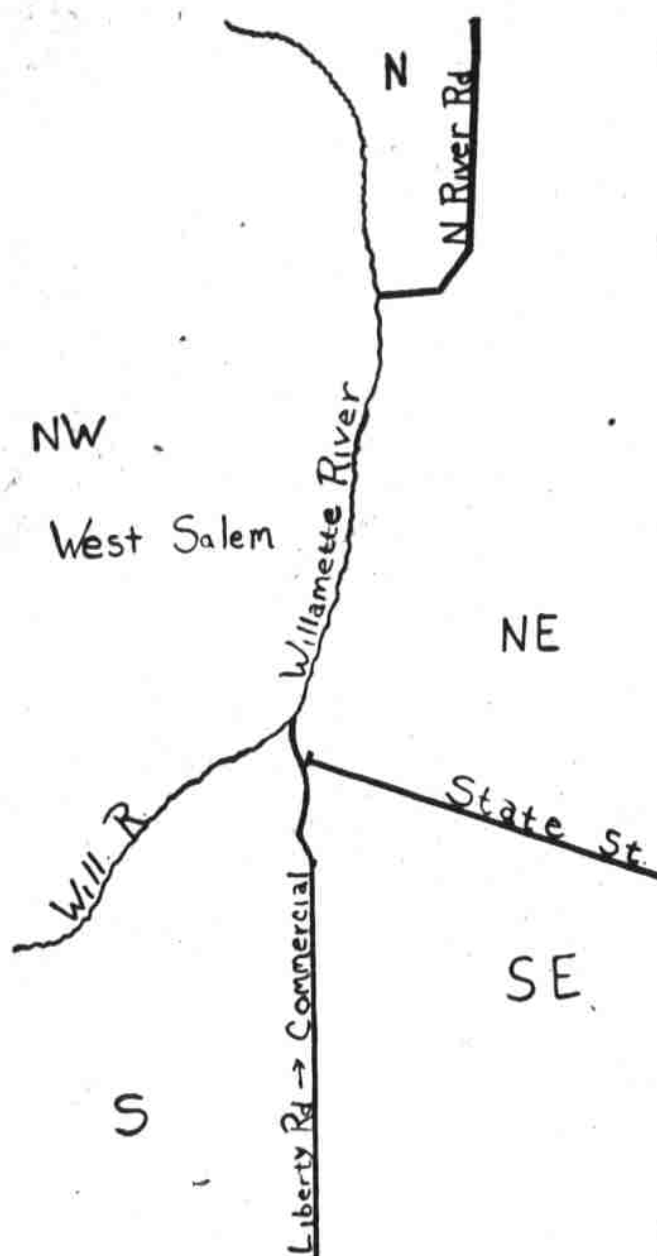

Work to Start This Week On New City Street Signs

City workmen early this week will begin replacing Salem's thousands of street signs with new signs bearing street name and suffix designations.

The work will begin in the south section of the city where approximately 250 new signs will go up. The city expects to use 1,500 sign posts and 3,000 signs before the job is completed. The first sign will go up at Mission and Commercial Streets.

Addition of street address suffixes has necessitated a lot of "catching on" for Salem residents, many of whom were just getting the hang of the old system when the city sprang the change.

Easier Identification

Purpose of the suffix, according to City Engineer J. H. DAVIS, is to make addresses more consistent with the city's geography and allow easier identification of addresses. The City Council effected the change last spring and gave it between two and three years to completely catch on.

The Council also authorized some 375 numerical address changes in the area west of Commercial Street between Mission Street and Rural Avenue. These changes were accomplished some months ago.

The new Salem telephone directory, due for circulation in January, will carry a partial change over to the new suffix system, reports Elmer Berglund, manager of the Salem offices of the Pacific telephone company. The Statesman has also put the change into use.

In the interest of clarification, and because many Salem business firms and all city and several county offices are using the suffixes, The Statesman offers the accompanying map and this brief description of the new system.

The suffixes are N, NE, NW, S, and SE.

Zones Listed

The zones they designate are as follows:

(1) Northeast (NE)—That part of Salem north of State Street and east of North River Road. Note both sides of N. River Rd. north of the sewage treatment plant will be numbered with a NE suffix. Example: 4055 River Rd. NE.

(2) Southeast (SE)—The area south of State Street and east of Commercial Street out Liberty Road. Both sides of Commercial Street and Liberty Road south of Mission Street will be numbered with a SE suffix. Example: 1635 Commercial St. SE.

(3) Northwest (NW)—All of West Salem and the area on the west side of the river.

Triangle Area

(4) North (N)—The triangle north of the sewage disposal plant and west of North River Road to the river.

(5) South (S)—The area south of State Street and west of Commercial Street and Liberty Road.

Both sides of State Street will be known only as State Street. Example: 2135 State St.

A sixth zone, Southwest (SW), applies only to a small stretch between the river and the NW area.

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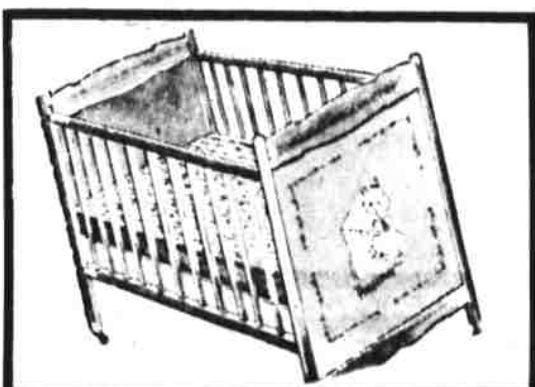
