U.N. General Assembly To Be Asked for Action On Charges by Syrians

UNITED NATIONS, N.Y., Oct. 20 (AP)—The U.N. General Assembly will get four or five resolutions calling for action on Syria's charges that Turkey plans to attack her, a usually reliable source said tonight.

Some will come in tomorrow, he said, and others Tuesday, when the 42-nation assembly is expected to start debate on the Soviet-backed Syrian complaint.

The United States and Peru

were known to be working on resolutions. The informant told a reporter it would be a good guess that Syria and the Soviet Union were too.

He said Saudi Arabian delegate Ahmed Shukary had been informed two days ago that King Saud was offering to mediate between Syria and Turkey with a view to removing "all causes of tension between the two, including the question of massing of troops."

No Official Word

But indications were that none of these three delegations involved had yet had official word tonight of Syrian and Turkish acceptance of this offer, reported by the British Broadcasting Corp., heard on the basis of a pickup from the Mecca radio.

One Western diplomat said the development "might change the picture radically." He expressed belief mediation might be helpful "if the Syrians accepted this thing in good faith." He said such acceptance "might also suggest they were happy to find a way of climbing down" from their charges.

Syria and Russia were promoting the idea of sending an investigating commission to the Syrian-Turkish frontier, where they say Turkey has concentrated troops for an imminent attack, Turkey has denied any such intention. The United States was reported anxious to give the commission a broader assignment that would take it to rear areas also and let it look into big-power influence in the two countries.

A Syrian source said Syria "would not be happy" to see the commission's task enlarged.

Queen Elizabeth II will visit the U.N. tomorrow afternoon. A British source said she would make a six-minute courtesy address to the Assembly. He added it would be nonpolitical.

Budapest Wallows In Intrigue

VIENNA, Austria, Oct. 20 (AP)—Budapest is a tensely nervous city under redoubled police and army guard and swarming with Communist informers, according to Western diplomats reaching Vienna today from the Hungarian capital.

The Hungarian capital's two million inhabitants were pictured as anxiously wondering whether there would be a new outbreak or even the most kind of demonstration to mark Wednesday's first anniversary of the Hungarian anti-Russian revolution that stirred the world.

Premier Janos Kadar, installed by the Russian occupiers after they crushed the revolt with tanks, has warned that any new uprising would also be smashed. Other government spokesmen have warned that even attempts to mark the anniversary with demonstrations would be "hit with an iron fist."

Orders Published

Orders have been published and broadcast that Oct. 23 and Nov. 4, the anniversary of the day the Russians attacked to crush the victorious rebels must be "normal" days—with everybody at work or at school.

In the past few days, diplomats said such articles as black neckties, scarves and armbands have vanished from Budapest shops even though wearing such items has been forbidden Wednesday because mourning that day will be considered a "counter-revolutionary demonstration." People who actually are in mourning for recently deceased relatives, or who commonly wear black in their work, have been told to wear some other color Wednesday.

Vote Aims at 'Weakening of Turk Nation'

IZMIR, Turkey, Oct. 20 (AP)—Premier Adnan Menderes told a huge campaign rally today the Moscow radio was urging Turks to vote for his opposition in the hope of weakening Turkey.

Speaking before a throng officially estimated at 100,000 at this daily session, Menderes said: "The Russian radio is telling people to vote for the Republican party. It is saying this not because the Russians like the Republicans. They know, as we know, that the Republican party is a national patriotic party.

Divide Country

"But the Russians hope to make the Republicans stronger and thus divide the country. That is why we want a great majority victory and I am confident we will get it."

The speech was the first of three major addresses Menderes plans before the national election Oct. 27, when the Turks will choose a new 540-member Parliament. He had been expected at long last to make a public statement on the Turkish-Syrian crisis, which has been receiving top headlines in the rest of the world while drawing only minor public interest in Turkey. But he never mentioned it.

Save for his closing paragraphs, the entire 75-minute speech was devoted to domestic issues. He spoke of the need for economic self-sufficiency.

Macmillan Said Aiming at Secret Aggression Plan

MOSCOW, Oct. 20 (AP)—Pravda said today British Prime Minister Macmillan is going to Washington to work out a secret plan of aggression against the Arab states. The voice of the Soviet Communist party said, "The British apparently feel the time has come to avenge the Suez adventure."

Pravda said Macmillan hopes by supporting the United States in "strengthening a coalition against the Arab countries" to get U.S. support for the British position on Yemen, Oman and the Persian Gulf. In addition, the paper went on, Macmillan will seek to obtain U.S. concessions on sharing nuclear secrets so far kept from the British. This, it said, has become a particularly pressing problem in view of the "tremendous success of the Soviet Union in the sphere of the ICBM and launching of an artificial earth satellite."
