

### Insurance On Autos To Jump

A 30 per cent increase in automobile insurance rates probably will go into effect in Oregon on Jan. 22, state insurance commissioner Hugh H. Earle said Monday.

Earle indicated he would approve the increase in a few days, asserting that most companies are losing money on their Oregon auto insurance business.

Earle said his actuary hasn't found any errors in data submitted in the application by the Oregon Assn. of Insurance Agents for the increase.

The biggest increase is for liability insurance, although increases also are sought for collision insurance.

The increases would vary for different areas of the state. The Portland suburban area, which has benefited from a lower rate than prevails in the city, would be placed in the same class as city automobile owners.

No definite information of the new Salem area rate is yet available.

### Four Drivers Fined; Another Asks Trial

Raymond Charles Helmig, Gervais, was fined \$250 in Marion County District Court Monday after a guilty plea on a charge of driving while intoxicated.

Fred James McKinney, 18, 1942 Center St. NE, pleaded guilty Monday in Marion County District Court to charges of possessing and displaying a fictitious motor vehicle driver's license and a chauffeur's license.

The cases were continued for sentencing to Dec. 31 at 9:30 a.m. on charges concerning a Dec. 17 arrest on Highway 99E near Hayesville by state police. Bail was set at \$50 on each charge.

A charge of drawing a bank check with insufficient funds was dismissed against William James Davis, Baker, Monday in Marion County District Court. He had been charged concerning a \$10 check given to a Salem service station on Oct. 24.

Kenneth Albert Tracey, Gladstone, requested a jury trial Monday after pleading innocent in Marion County District Court to a charge of driving while intoxicated.

Tracey was arrested Dec. 29 on Highway 99E near the Wacanda Junction by state police for allegedly driving at high speeds and zig-zagging on the highway. Trial date was to be set.

Paul White, Brooks, was fined \$200 after a guilty plea Monday in Marion County District Court on a charge of driving while intoxicated.

White was arrested Dec. 28 by state police near Labish Center after allegedly driving slowly down the middle of the highway.

Earl Kennedy Jr., 2307 Fairgrounds Rd. NE, was fined \$50 Monday in Marion County District Court after pleading guilty to a charge of driving with his operator's license suspended.

Kennedy was arrested on Highway 99 at the south Woodburn junction by state police on Dec. 13.

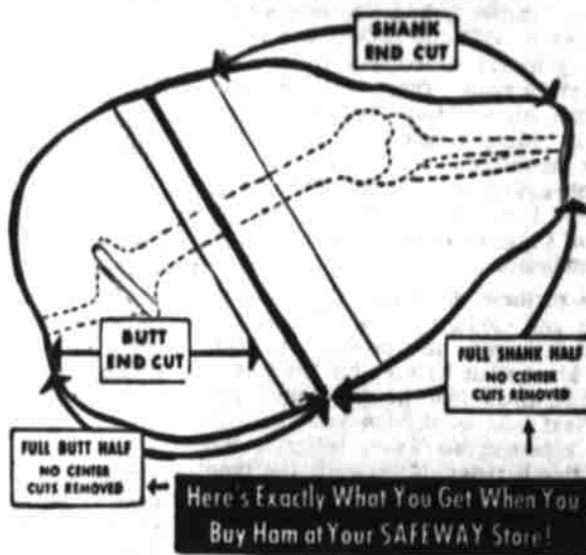
